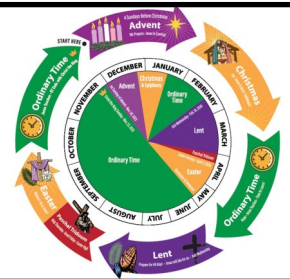

Prayers for victims of Human Trafficking

Each year, 8th February (when not a Sunday) is the memorial of Saint Josephine Bakhita, the patron saint of victims of human trafficking and modern slavery. There are 50 million victims of human trafficking across the world and as many as 130,000 in the UK, hidden in plain sight in your neighbourhood. Pope Francis described human trafficking as "blood money" and a "crime against humanity". We are all called to combat this evil trade. You will see that our Holy Hour times at both Sacred Heart and Our Lady's this week are dedicated to victims of human trafficking.
