Questions

- Compare the meals Jesus has in Luke's resurrection story with the ones in John's. How are they similar and different? What function do they have?
- Jesus tells Peter to "feed his sheep." Back in John 10, Jesus gives an entire discourse on himself as the shepherd and the care of the sheep. How does John 10 help you understand what all Jesus is asking of Peter?
- The scene on the beach is the third time Jesus has revealed himself to the disciples in John's gospel. What does this suggest to us about our understanding of the resurrection and its impact?
