





CIVIL CONSTRUCTION TECHNICAL TRAINING PROGRAM

Earthworks Construction on Major Road **Projects**

This program will create training that is accessible and industryled for new and existing Victorian Infrastructure Delivery Authority and Contractor workforce.

The scale, complexity and breadth of major road projects across Victoria is on the rise, with unprecedented investment in the State's road infrastructure.

Participants will focus their understanding on earthworks construction, risks and the critical need for understanding their role in MRPV. The Earthworks Construction course aims to increase technical capability and improve the quality of road and bridge civil construction by delivering standardised technical information and training.

It has been designed and delivered by Major Road Projects Victoria, on behalf of the Victorian government's Victorian Infrastructure Delivery Authority, and in partnership with the National Transport Research Organisation (NTRO).



The Earthworks Construction Training course aims to enhance participants' basic earthworks and formation good practice knowledge and provide confidence when undertaking earthworks and road formation.

The course will cover:

- Best practice methods
- Key roles, requirements and approaches
- The relevant technical specifications and requirements for earthworks construction
- Basic construction methods and equipment
- Environmental requirements
- Health and safety requirements
- Importance of quality control.

Learning objectives

At the completion of the training, participants will have consolidated their existing skills and knowledge of Earthworks Construction and will have gained a better understanding of:

- The types, quality and uses of materials used information construction.
- The terminologies used in earthworks and road formation.
- Basic requirements of setting out for formation construction.
- Basic construction methods and equipment used.
- Basic elements of VicRoads/Austroads standard specifications.
- Basic elements in compaction theory.
- Specific safety hazards involved in earthworks and road formation.
- New technologies, sustainability and operations in earthworks and road formation.

Course structure

This course is delivered face to face over one day.

Participants will receive a Certificate of Attendance upon completion.
