2. About cookies

Cookies are small text files containing limited amounts of information which are downloaded and stored on the User's device through their web browser whenever they visit a website.

Cookies may be categorised according to the purpose they serve. Some cookies are strictly necessary for the operation of the Website, while others collect statistical information to analyse the Website's usage and performance. Additional cookies may be used to provide enhanced Website functionality or to remember the User's browsing preferences whenever the same device is used.
