From Schoolhouse to Homes: Revitalizing Peeples Street for West End Families

The City of Atlanta, Atlanta Public Schools (APS), and the Atlanta Urban Development Corporation (AUDC) are partnering to transform the former Peeples Street Elementary School site into a new residential community that reflects the heart and history of the West End. Built between 1910 and 1915, Peeples Street Elementary served local families for decades before closing in 1970. Today, the 5.8-acre site is vacant land — but with your input, it's about to become a vibrant, family-friendly neighborhood once again.

What the Community Asked For:

- **homeownership:** At least 15% of the homes will be owner-occupied.
- **Mean in the state of the heighborhood's character:** Smaller buildings and single-family homes.
- **Kamily-sized homes:** At least 85% will be 2- or 3-bedroom homes.
- No commercial uses: The site will remain fully residential.
- **Mistoric character preserved:** Designs will follow West End Historic District guidelines.

Design Highlights

- Homes will face the street with porches, sidewalks, and front yards to match the existing neighborhood style.
- Materials like brick, wood, or smooth siding will be used to blend with surrounding homes.
- A Parking will be placed behind homes no front yard driveways.
- **E** Building height, rooflines, and spacing will follow the West End Historic District's compatibility guidelines.
- Public sidewalks will match historic paving styles, and carports/garages will be built at the back of properties.
