PROJECT OVERVIEW AND SITE CONTEXT

- The property at 360 Autumn Lane SW is the former Rosalie Wright Elementary School site, approximately 1.9 acres.
- Located in the Florida Heights neighborhood, within NPU-I and City Council District 10 (Councilmember Andrea L. Boone).
- In collaboration with the **City of Atlanta**, **Atlanta Public Schools**, and **Atlanta Urban Development**, this community-driven planning process will explore opportunities for accessible and inclusive housing options—supporting affordability, equity, and long-term neighborhood stability.



PURPOSE OF THE COMMUNITY ADVISORY TEAM (CAT)

- The **CAT** will consist of **4 dedicated local stakeholders**, including residents, business owners, youth, and faith leaders.
- **Monthly meetings** will begin in **January 2026**.
- The CAT will:
 - Provide input on design, land use, and community goals
 - Represent diverse voices in the neighborhood (renters, homeowners, longtime residents, small businesses)
- Serve as a communication bridge between the project team and the community

PROJECT TIMELINE & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT MILESTONES

Phase	Key Activities
November – December 2025	Select planning consultant & identify Community Advisory Team (CAT)
Jan 2026	Kick-off with RHWCC & NPU-I; CAT #1 convenes
February – March 2026	Public design charrettes; presentations and feedback sessions
Apr 2026	Submit proposed zoning/land use changes
May – June 2026	Community votes of support via RHWCC & NPU-I
Jul 2026	Final approvals through City Council
