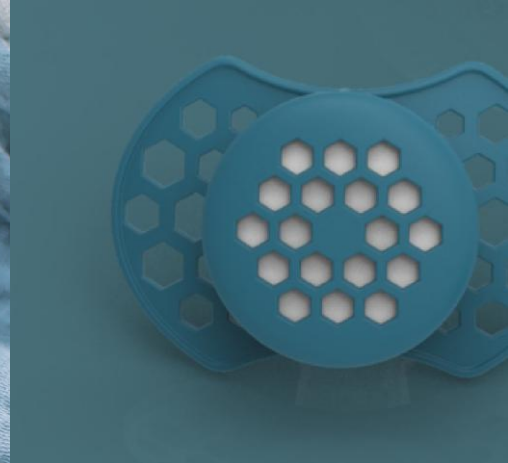

## Supports Airway Hygiene

- Breese® is **NOT** a typical pacifier.
- **Intended Purpose:**
  - In its pacifier-like design, Breese® filters the air inhaled through the mouth.
  - It thus supports breathing during mouth breathing periods (e. g. limitation of ability to breathe though the nose during episodes of infantile nasal congestion).

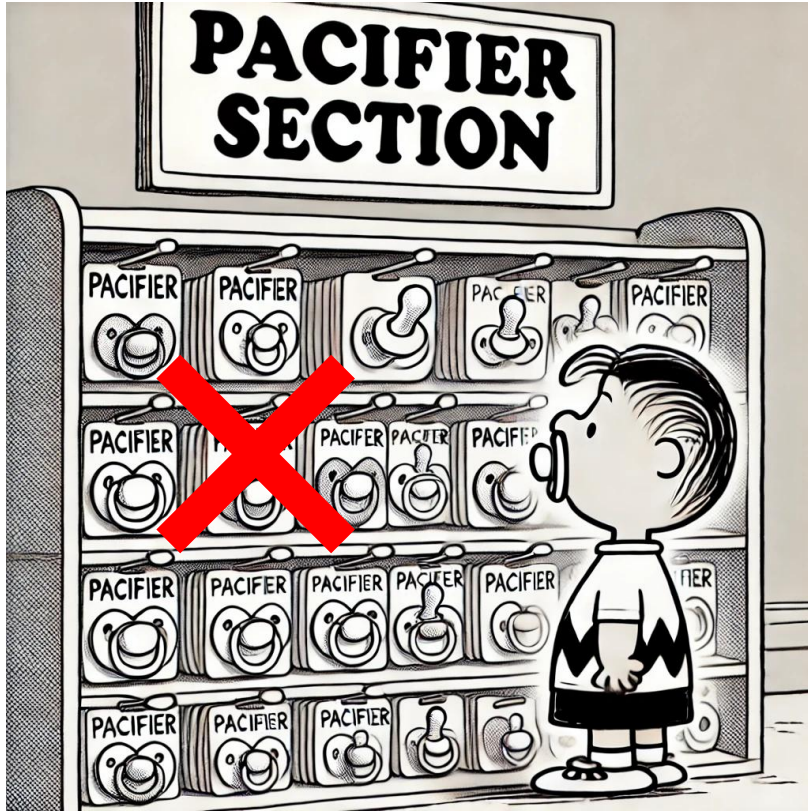
# Brease® // Key Features



- Inspired by the design of classical pacifiers to **support acceptance and compliance**.
- Features an **opening in the teat that enables airflow** from the surrounding air into the mouth.
- A **removable filter capsule** contains an air filter that should be replaced daily.
- The **filter captures bacteria, viruses, pollen and particulate matter** (e. g. dust) from incoming air.
- Unlike the nasal airway, which naturally filters inhaled air through mucociliary clearance, the oropharyngeal airway has no comparable filtering function.
- **Air inhaled through Brease® is filtered**, helping to compensate for the lack of filtering function in the oropharyngeal airway and **promoting airway hygiene**.
- **Supports alleviation of breathing inconvenience** in children with nasal congestion.
- Can be used in combination with inhalation devices (e.g. Softbreezer®, Ecomyst®) via an adapter.
