The role is for a support worker working in a private placement supporting a 20-year-old autistic, non-verbal male in his own private residential setting with great facilities including a swimming pool and extensive grounds available for fun activities. There is some occasional lone working shifts but lots of shifts are 2-1, teaming up with other team members to go out on outings and into the community.
