WHY WE FAST

- → We fast in repentance for revival. We fast and pray personally for our nation and for the church worldwide. (2 Chronicles 7:14, Daniel 9:3-19). Christian fasting is for personal relationship with Jesus and a deeper revelation of his person. (Matthew 6:16-18; 9:15).
- → We fast for empowerment for service. Jesus fasted and prayed at the onset of His own ministry (Matthew 4:2), and His fast was followed with angelic visitation and Holy Spirit power (Matthew 4:11, Luke 4:14).
- There is also an empowerment for deliverance of others in prayer and fasting. (Isaiah 58:6, Mark 9:29)
