Whether you can commit to a day or a year, you can accredit various STEM outreach activities across all Industrial Cadets levels.

Challenger



STEM taster activities

Taster STEM activities, short teacher or student-led competitions, company experience days, STEM resources

Bronze



~20 hours

Environmental projects, shorter virtual or face-to-face work experience, Routes into STEM, challenge-based competitions

Silver



~30 hours

Virtual/face-to-face work experience, Insight into University, project-based experiences, challenge-based competitions

Gold



~50 hours

Industry-led projects, virtual/face-to-face work experience, extended challenge-based competitions, summer placements

Platinum & Platinum Leader*



9-12 month work placement

Industrial placements, Year in Industry placements, apprenticeships

For Industrial Cadets **Bronze, Silver and Gold**, the programme includes a combination of guided and independent learning hours

*Students undertaking Industrial Cadets Platinum have the option to achieve Industrial Cadets Platinum Leader through additional time spent on education and community outreach and volunteering



CREATING FUTURE PATHWAYS TO EMPLOYMENT
