









- Repaired all windows
- Fixed exterior cladding and corner boxing
- Installed new sliding door
- New bathroom and toilet
- New stove
- Laid electrical wiring underground to power cabins
- Fixed all faulty power points and light fixtures
- Installed full length doublelined curtains and tracks throughout home













Krystal's whare repairs

- Insulated walls, ceiling and underfloor
- Lined walls and ceiling of entire cabin
- Built stair way entry into home
- Designed and installed solar panels to power cabin
