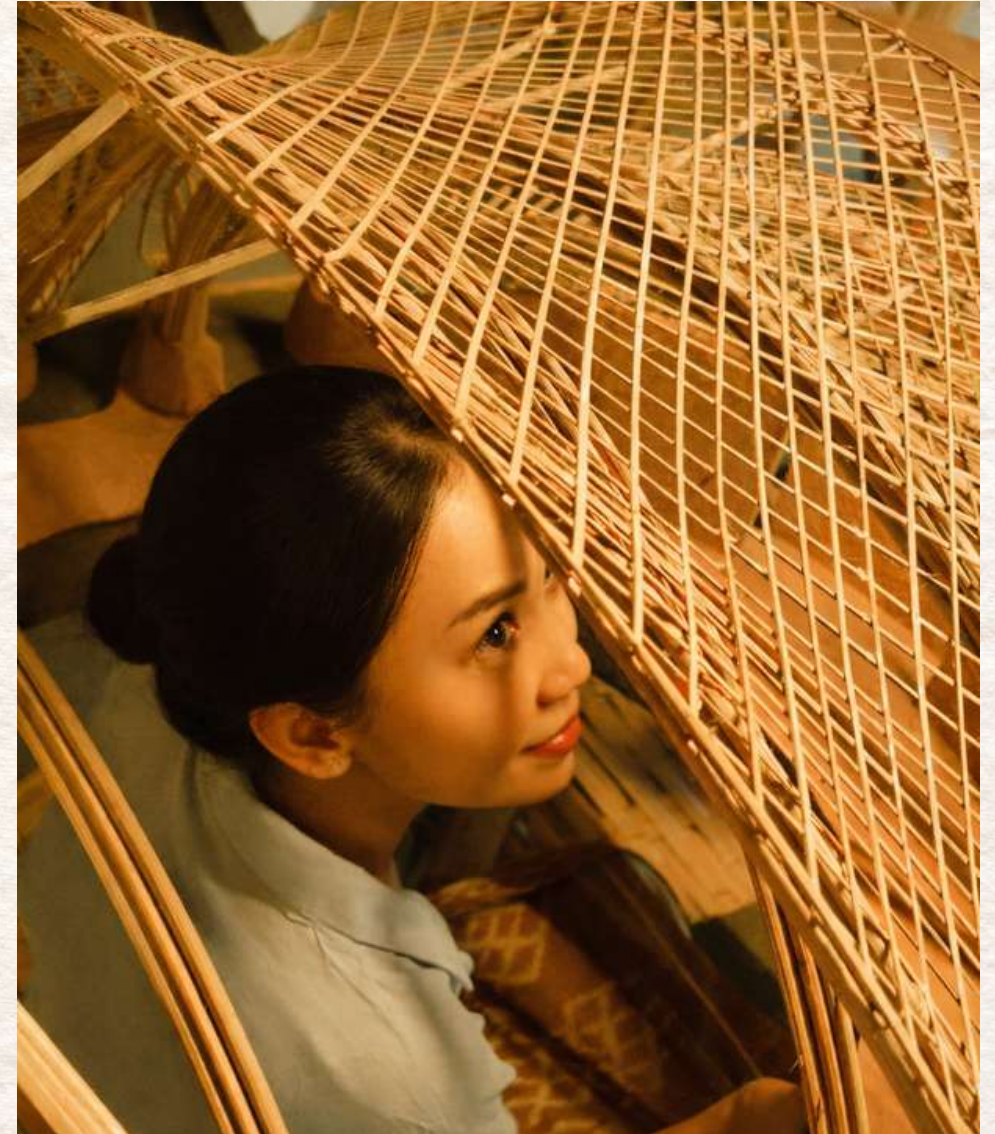

Bambu Indah Nature & Trash Walk

With the help of a local guide, sharp stick and a rice sack contribute to the beauty of Bali by spearing and gathering trash along your nature walk.

MUKA CONCEPTS x BAMBU INDAH

MUKA SIGNATURE ASIAN MASSAGE 90 minutes | IDR 950,000

A traditional dry Japanese massage performed on a soft mat, using the stable weight from the therapist's feet to apply long, rhythmic pressure along key energetic points. Releases tension and improves circulation.

MUKA FULL BODY MASSAGE 90 minutes | IDR 950,000

Muka's signature full body massage begins by warming up the body with dry kneading, followed by deep tissue work with our Cempaka Flower Butter to release tension and increase blood flow to sore muscles. Gua Sha massage is then applied to the back. The massage ends with cupping therapy to help detoxify the body.

MUKA FULL BODY SCRUB 60 minutes | IDR 950,000

Muka's signature full-body scrub uses only handmade, natural Muka products to exfoliate, cleanse, and relax the body.

MUKA GUASHA FACE LIFTING MASSAGE 60 minutes | IDR 750,000

Facial massage specifically to relieve wrinkles, regenerate scarring, followed with a calming turmeric mask.

MUKA SIGNATURE FACIAL 90 minutes | IDR 950,000

This signature facial begins with gentle strokes on the face to improve circulation, followed by a gentle facial scrub, extractions, a cleansing antibacterial turmeric mask, soothing seaweed serum, and buccal massage. All Muka skincare products used are natural and handmade.

Specialized Massages

HEALING THERAPY WITH PAK KADEK

Working with the four elements of water, fire, wind and earth, Pak Kadek will realign, clear and charge your chakras (energy centers). While working on your hands and feet using Reflexology, he can assess your internal health and identify problem areas. A fountain of wisdom about the body and spirit, Kadek can also help you to put together a plan to balance your ongoing lifestyle.

Two excellent massage therapists trained internationally in the Esalen technique. This special modality uses smooth, strong movements, massaging the body from head to toe with gentle twists to relieve knots and tension. An incredibly professional, nurturing and restorative massage.

Pranic Healing & Balinese Massage

The goal of this session or treatment is for physical and psychological therapy

Healing the mind and body begins with Pranic Healing, an energy-based, non-contact modality designed to shift your life-force and cleanse the body's aura and chakras. Followed by a soothing and relaxing Balinese traditional full-body massage.

Acupuncture & Deep Tissue Massage

The goal of this session or treatment is to restore muscular problem

Acupuncture and Deep Tissue Massage are therapeutic modalities specifically designed to address and treat various muscular issues including prolonged and chronic pain conditions

Pranic Healing and Acupuncture

The goal of this session or treatment is to rebalance and calm

This session begins with an assessment of your unique needs. With that in mind, the non-contact Pranic healing session cleanses and replenishes with the powerful energy of Prana (life-force). Gentle acupuncture follows, placing needles in the areas most needed to rebalance and heal, and to bring about a deep mind-body-spirit connection.

Acupuncture & Lymphatic Drainage Therapy

The goal of this session or treatment is to unblock the Chi and drain the toxin to the lymphatic system

This session begins with an ancient massage technique targeting specific points around the abdomen to release tension from negative emotions, then followed by reflexology to stimulate the body's innate healing abilities.

Indian Scalp Massage & Relaxing Massage

The goal of this session or treatment is for deep relaxation

Release the tension from the mind and head, and carry it on through the entire body. We begin with a seated massage on the scalp, neck, and shoulders to release stuck energy caused by stress. Then, surrender to a reclining full-body massage designed to cool and fully relax the whole system.

WATSU HEALING

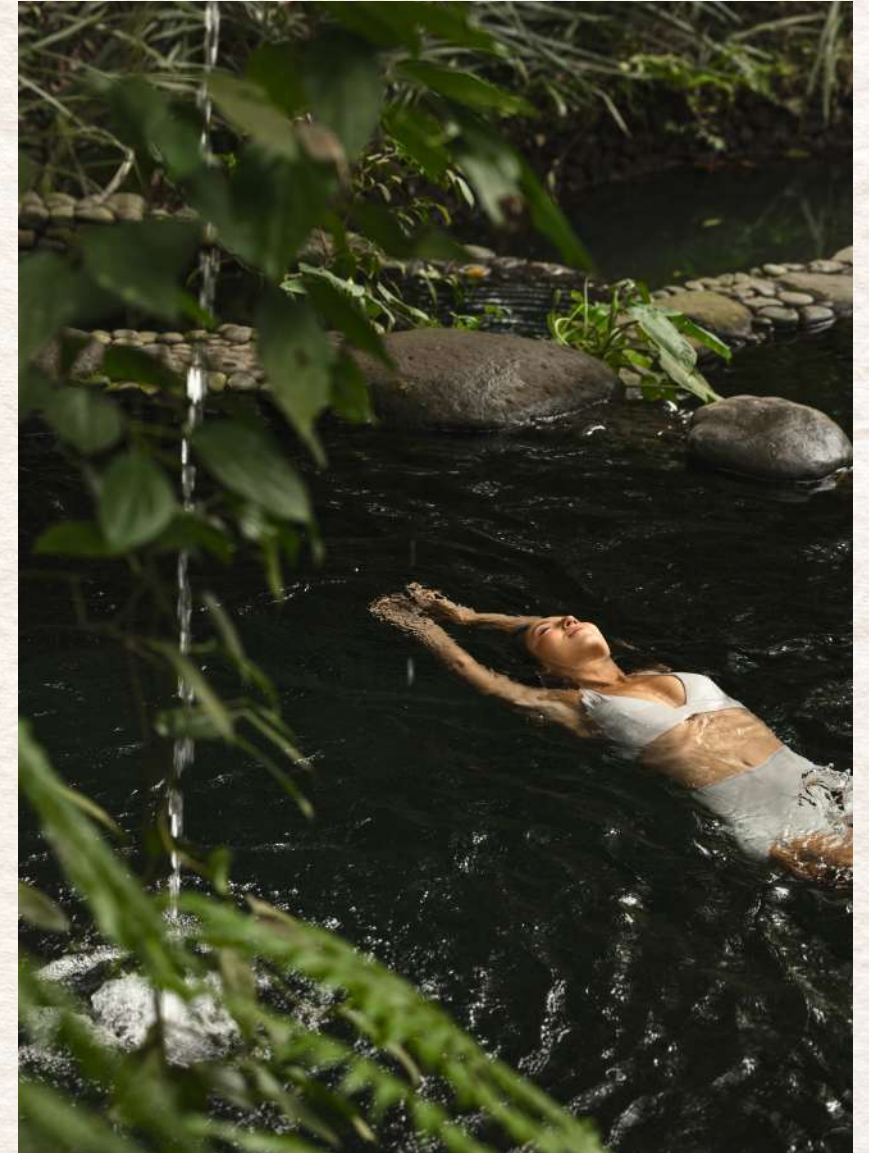
Aquatic bodywork in a fire-heated, spring-fed pool beside the Ayung River

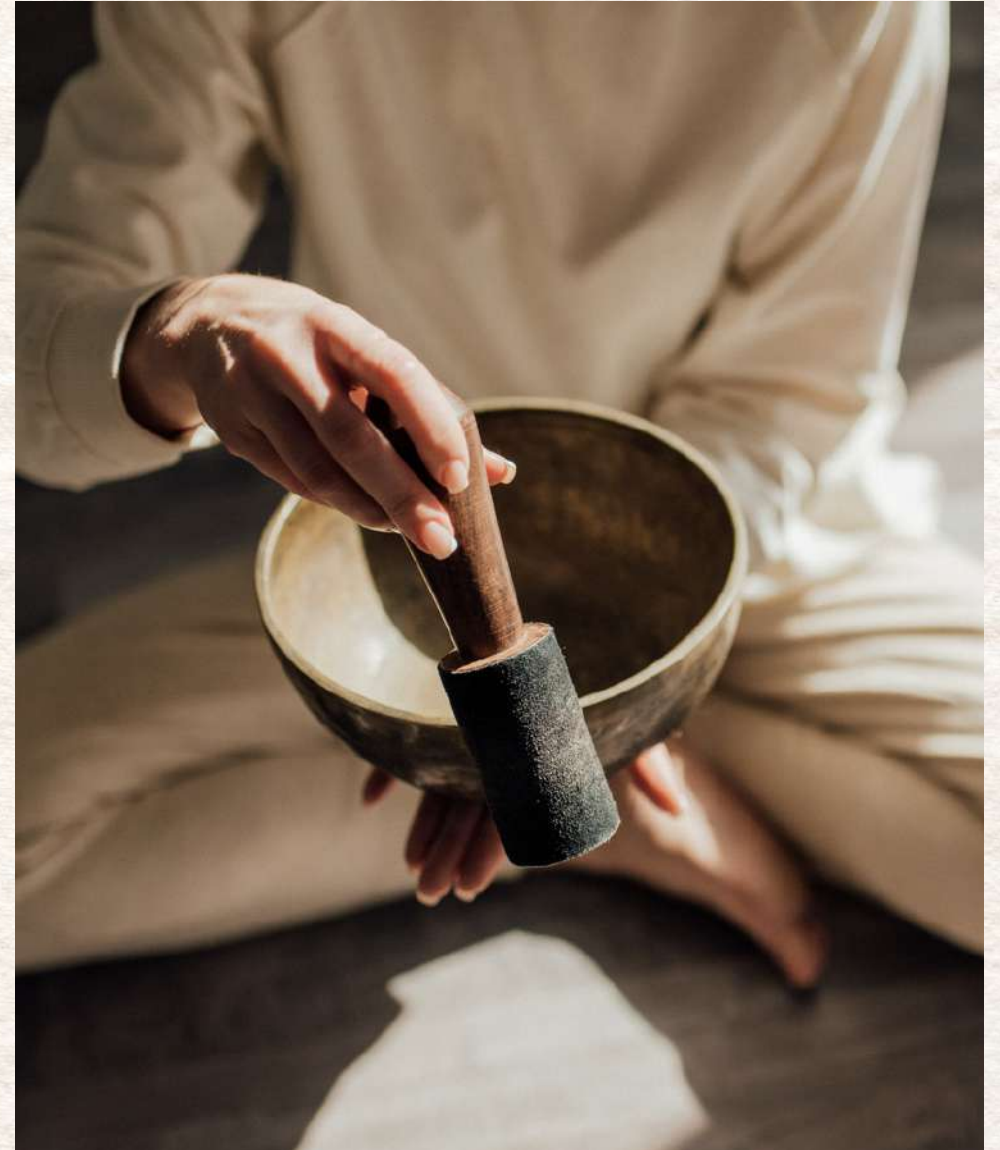
SOUND HEALING JOURNEY

An immersive sound healing experience designed to harmonize the mind, body, and soul. RICE PLANTING & HARVESTING *(based on season)*

Our rice paddies are a quintessential part of the Bambu Indah experience — they are regenerating the land to how it was used centuries ago, and they provide all of the rice we serve our guests. Most visitors who have eaten rice all their lives have never had the pleasure of planting or harvesting it.

Several times a year, we invite you to help us do both — it's straightforward, if strenuous, work, but also meditative and fulfilling. The effect can be very powerful. Guaranteed, you'll find a new appreciation for rice!



VISA ON ARRIVAL Your VOA can be purchased directly at the airport, and it will last for exactly 30 days. You will be able to pay in various currencies at the arrival gate. Note that the VOA is not required for all countries.

MOBILE PHONE

Getting an Indonesian SIM card is a simple operation. Your phone must be unlocked to use an overseas SIM card. A local phone can also be purchased easily for as little as 300'000 Rp. The credit for cell phone use, which is called “pulsar” can be bought in many local shops (Circle K, Alfamart, Indomarket...). You can also purchase Internet credit “data” for cellular data usage. 100'000 Rp worth of pulsa/data can be enough for local phone calls and texts and some navigation and web browsing. Note that it is standard for local vendors to add a very small transaction fee (3'000 Rp) when you buy credit.

CURRENCY & BANKING

Find daily exchange rates on the website <http://www.xe.com>. Debit cards are not accepted in most hotels, shops and restaurants. It is safer to travel with more than one credit card, in case of a problem. Always carry enough cash with you, especially when traveling to remote places where ATMs are less easy to find (North and West Bali, Nusa Lembongan, Nusa Penida, Gili Islands).

AIRPORT DEPARTURE TAXES

It is usually included in ticket price. Please contact your airline or travel agent for further information.

TAXES

It is common in Bali to list prices without including the 21% government tax and service charges. Take the time to check in order to avoid being surprised with a different bill than you expected.

SCOOTERS

Many people travel using scooters on the Island, as it is more convenient during high traffic times, and also a nice way to discover the local life and hidden paths. The fun is obvious, but traveling on two wheels has its risks. We strongly advise taking cars over scooters whenever possible, and we advise not driving a scooter if you've never driven one before. To legally drive a scooter in Bali you must hold an international driver's license, usually procured in your home country. Please note that many travel insurance companies will not cover you without the proper license.

TAXIS

Make sure you always agree on a price before departing. Various areas are ruled by the local taxis, making it sometimes impossible to call online taxis (Gojek/Grab) to pick you up. Online taxis tend to be available in Kuta, Legian, Seminyak and some parts of Canggu, Uluwatu and Ubud, but not all. We are happy to help you arrange cars and drivers, including to and from the airport.



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
