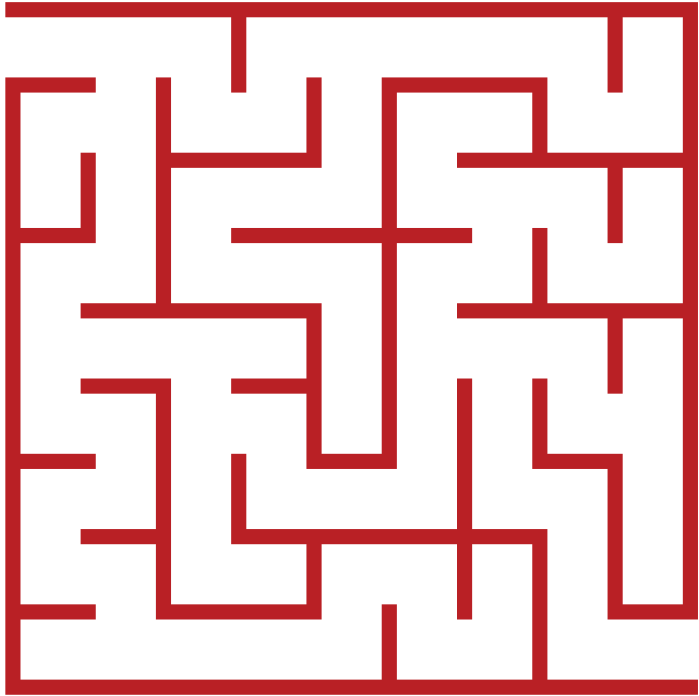

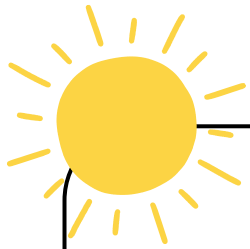

Tip from Ollie

Are you looking for a way to make money this summer? Try out my favorite lemonade recipe and do a lemonade stand with your friends!



Lemonade Recipe

- ~ 4-5 medium sized lemons
(Ranges from \$1 per lemon or about \$4.00 for a bag)
- ~ 1 and $\frac{1}{2}$ cups of Sugar
- ~ 1 cup of Hot Water
- ~ 4 cups of Cold Water

Instructions

- 1) Roll lemons on cutting board to loosen juice
- 2) Cut lemons in half and squeeze out fresh lemon juice (can use juicer and remember to remove any seeds)
- 3) Dissolve 1 and $\frac{1}{2}$ cups sugar in 1 cup of hot water. Stir well!
- 4) Pour in fresh squeezed lemon juice
- 5) Add in 4 cups of cold water and stir
- 6) Pour into pitcher and serve!
