## **Cookie Policy**

During your visit to the FRENETIC website, www.frenetic.ai, the company may collect personal data, mainly through the use of cookies.

A cookie is a small text file that a server can place on the hard disk of the computer in the browser, tablet, mobile phone or, in short, in the device used to browse the Internet and which contains information about the user's visit to the website, their browsing preferences, the information they are most interested in, language, etc.

The user can configure cookies and decide whether to reject the installation of cookies or accept them. If you have continued browsing without taking any action, you have accepted the installation of cookies, as you are informed in the first layer panel. FRENETIC recommends that cookies are accepted because they do not invade the privacy of users and because they provide relevant information to be able to continue offering quality content.

Depending on their nature, cookies can be classified as follows:

**Session Cookies and Permanent Cookies**: the former are deleted when the browser is closed, while the latter remain on the computer equipment.

**Own cookies and third-party cookies**: depending on whether they belong to the owner of the website or to a third party.

Cookies may be used to collect specific information during your visit to the Website. The purpose of using cookies is to improve the navigation and its functionality conditions, as this information can help FRENETIC to ensure that the website and services are tailored as closely as possible to the needs and preferences of its users.

**Third-party cookies**: in this case, FRENETIC may install third-party cookies in order to be able to offer you information that we consider to be of interest to you during browsing. Usually the use of third party cookies will refer to analytical cookies that provide FRENETIC with anonymous information regarding the number of accesses to the website, the time that the user is on the website, as well as other statistical data.

Cookies necessary for browsing: The installation of this type of cookies is necessary for browsing, as well as for FRENETIC to have information that is legally required, such as that the data subject has accepted the cookies policy or that he/she has rejected when accessing the website.

In addition to the above settings, you can set your Internet browser to notify you each time a new cookie is stored on your computer so that you can decide whether to accept or reject it. Please note that some parts of the Website may not function properly if you reject cookies.

To allow, know, block or delete the cookies installed on your computer, you can do so by configuring the options of the browser installed on your computer.
