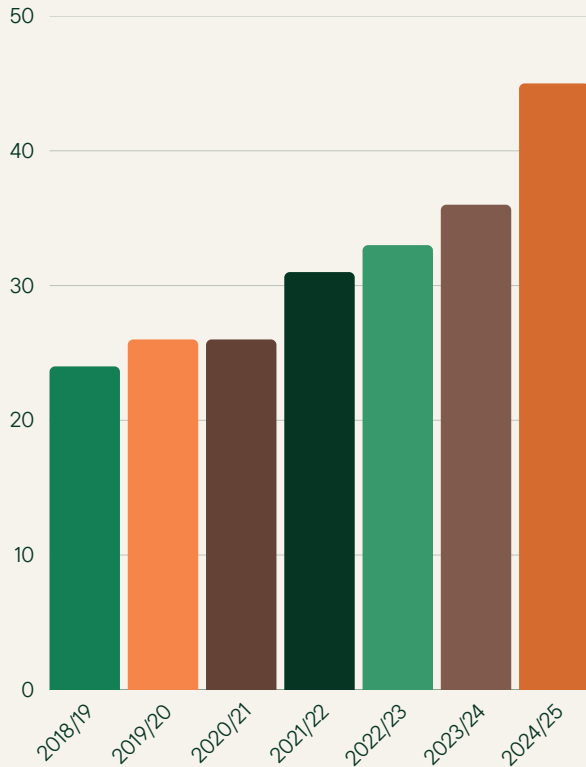


2025 Impact Report

Enrollment Growth Over Time



87% of parents reported noticeable growth in their child's emotional regulation, confidence, or social skills outside of THS.

86% of students showed measurable growth on end-of-year reading assessments.

90% of students showed measurable growth on end-of-year math assessments.

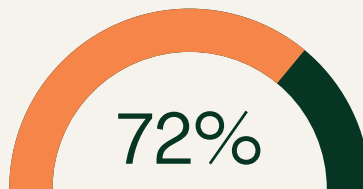
