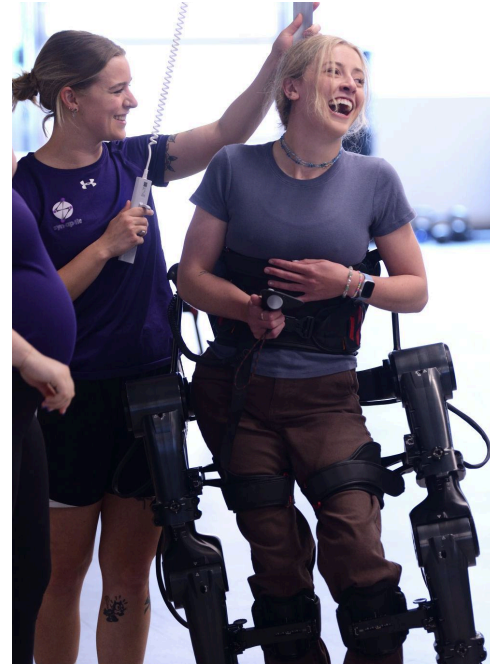

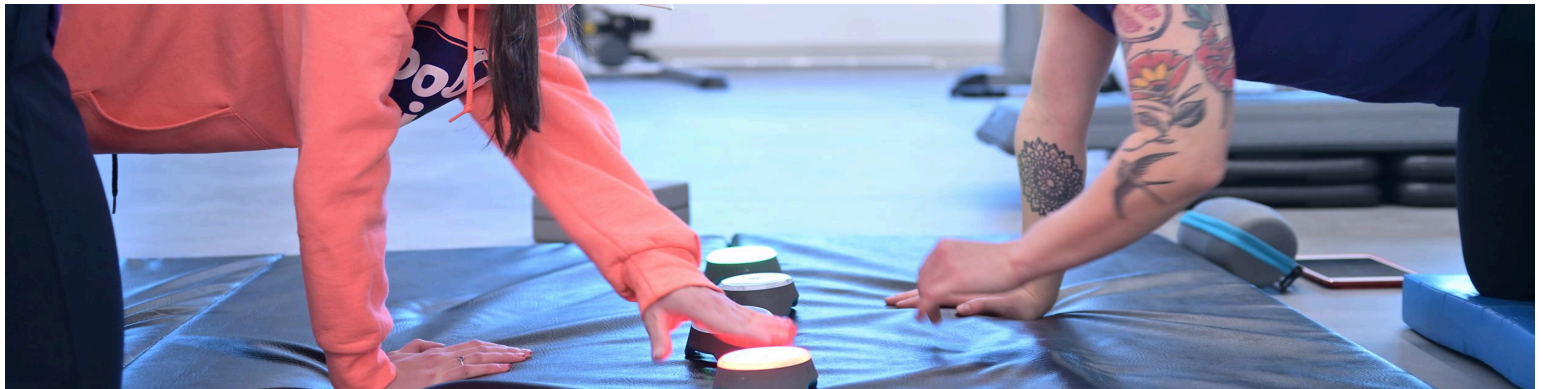
### Back to competition
