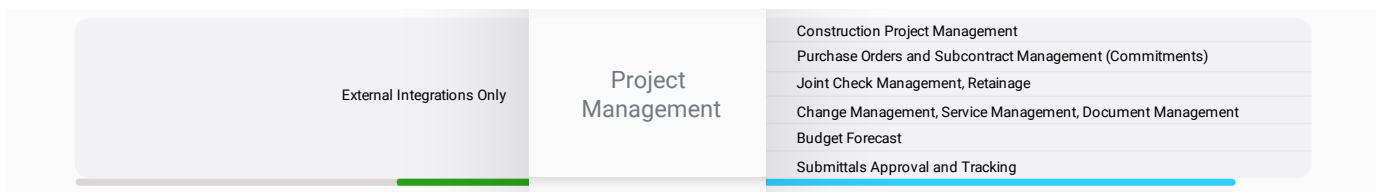

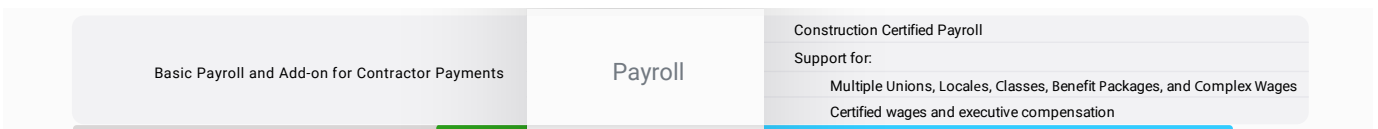

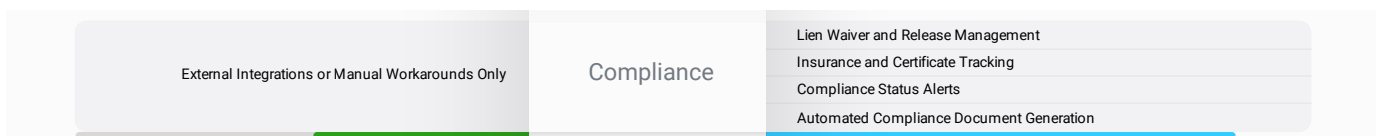

Acumatica also supports automated compliance document generation, prevailing wages, and labor rules for certified and union projects, helping you stay compliant without extra manual work.

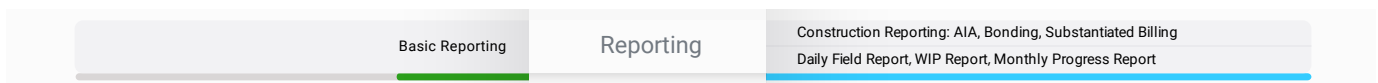


Real-Time Reporting
