This methodology promotes collaborative and interdisciplinary learning among civil society organizations (CSOs), academia, the public sector, and the private sector.

Phases of the Methodological Process

Diagnosis and Mapping

Identification of key issues affecting citizens and civil society organizations through interviews, surveys, and context analysis.

Development of a situational report and social intelligence workshops using participatory methodologies.

Training and Capacity Development

Implementation of the Social Innovation School for human rights defenders.

Workshops on project management, digital security, strategic communication, and advocacy methodologies.

Personalized advisory and mentorship with experts in social innovation and sustainability.

Co-Creation and Experimentation

Social Resilience Hackathons to design digital and methodological solutions for crisis response.

Negotiation simulations with key actors and practical advocacy exercises.

Prototyping of applications, anonymous reporting platforms, and digital tools for documenting abuses.

Implementation and Evaluation

Creation of Innovation and Social Transformation Labs focused on peace and economic sustainability for CSOs.

Development of collaborative networks and security circles for CSOs and human rights defenders.

Cascade funding allocation for the implementation of innovative and sustainable projects.

Monitoring and impact evaluation using sustainability and scalability metrics.
