

Inco x Megapot Summer Game Jam — Terms & Conditions

Effective: 7.29.2026

These Terms & Conditions ("Terms") govern your participation in the **Inco x Megapot Summer Game Jam** (the "Event"), an online onchain gaming hackathon organized by Liquidbox Corp. dba Inco ("Inco," "Organizer," "we," "us"), together with Megapot and any partners or sponsors of the Event (collectively, the "Organizers"). By registering for or participating in the Event, you agree to these Terms. If you do not agree, do not participate.

These Terms are Supplemental Terms to, and incorporate by reference, Inco's Terms of Use available at <https://inco.org> (the "General Terms"). By registering for or participating in the Event, you also agree to the General Terms, which continue to apply in full — including their provisions on dispute resolution and binding arbitration, class action and jury trial waiver, disclaimers, limitation of liability, and governing law. These Terms address matters specific to the Event; where these Terms directly conflict with the General Terms on an Event-specific matter, these Terms control, and on all other matters the General Terms control.

1. The Event

1.1 The Event is conducted entirely online. There is no physical venue, and no in-person attendance is required or offered.

1.2 The Event runs from 29 July 2026 to 14 August 2026, with the submission deadline at the end of 14 August 2026 EDT. Organizers may adjust these dates and will communicate any changes through official channels.

1.3 Participation is free. You are responsible for your own equipment, software, internet access, and any network or gas fees incurred while building or deploying your project.

2. Eligibility

2.1 You must be at least 18 years old to participate.

2.2 You are responsible for ensuring that your participation and receipt of any prize is lawful in your jurisdiction. The Event is void where prohibited or restricted by law.

2.3 You are not eligible if you are located in, or are a resident or national of, any country or region subject to comprehensive sanctions, or if you are on any applicable sanctions or

restricted-party list. Employees, contractors, and immediate family members of the Organizers directly involved in running or judging the Event are not eligible to win prizes.

2.4 Teams may have up to 5 members. Each participant may be part of only one team.

3. Registration & Submission

3.1 To register, you must complete the official registration/submission form and provide accurate, current information.

3.2 To qualify for judging, a submission must include:

- a working, publicly accessible prototype or product;
- a functional Inco or Megapot integration;
- Inco or Megapot incorporated into the main user loop of the game; and
- a public code repository or, for proprietary projects, a detailed integration write-up.

3.3 Submissions must be received before the stated deadline. Organizers may, at their discretion, decline or disqualify submissions that are incomplete, non-functional, or that do not meet the qualification requirements.

4. Originality & Pre-existing Work

4.1 Your project should be substantially built during the Event. You may use open-source libraries, frameworks, public SDKs, and third-party APIs (including Inco and Megapot tooling) as building blocks.

4.2 You must disclose in writing any pre-existing, project-specific work included in your submission, along with details in your repository history and description.

4.3 If a submission contains undisclosed pre-existing work, or materially misrepresents what was built during the Event, it may be disqualified, any prize revoked, and the team may be excluded from future events. Using version control with a genuine commit history is strongly recommended; single bulk commits without history may be treated as unqualified unless you can demonstrate otherwise.

5. Intellectual Property

5.1 You (and your team) retain all right, title, and interest in the projects and developments you create during the Event, including all intellectual property rights therein.

5.2 You acknowledge that you may access products, information, SDKs, APIs, or other materials belonging to Organizers, partners, or third parties ("Third Party Materials"). Nothing in these Terms transfers any ownership of Third Party Materials to you. Your rights to Third Party

Materials are only those expressly granted by their owners, and any APIs or software provided by partners remain subject to their own license and subscription terms.

5.3 By submitting, you grant the Organizers a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free license to display, reproduce, and describe your submission (including its name, description, screenshots, demo, and links) for the purpose of promoting the Event and its results.

6. Judging

6.1 Submissions will be evaluated against the judging criteria published on the resources page at <https://www.inco.org/blog/summer-game-jam-resources-and-what-to-build> (the "resources page").

6.2 Judging is conducted by judges selected by the Organizers. Judges' and Organizers' decisions are final and binding. Organizers reserve the right to withhold or reallocate prizes if there are insufficient qualifying submissions.

7. Prizes

7.1 Prizes consist of cash and/or Megaport tickets depending on the prize track. Full prize details for each track are set out on the resources page. Organizers may adjust prize details and will communicate any changes through official channels.

7.2 Prizes will be distributed to winners using the method and details communicated to them after results are announced. You are responsible for providing accurate information needed to receive a prize.

7.3 Prizes are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for alternatives except at the Organizers' discretion.

7.4 Winners may be required to complete identity verification (KYC) and provide any information reasonably necessary for the Organizers to lawfully distribute prizes. Failure to do so within a reasonable period may result in forfeiture.

7.5 You are solely responsible for any taxes, duties, or reporting obligations arising from receipt of a prize.

7.6 The Organizers reserve the right to determine, allocate, and distribute prizes as they see fit, including deciding the form, timing, and manner of distribution, splitting or combining prizes, awarding additional or fewer prizes, and adjusting or withholding any prize. All prize decisions are made at the Organizers' sole discretion and are final.

8. Code of Conduct

8.1 All participants are expected to treat one another with respect. Harassment of any kind will not be tolerated, including offensive comments related to gender, sexual orientation, disability, age, socioeconomic status, ethnicity, appearance, race, or religion; sexual language or imagery; deliberate intimidation; stalking; or unwelcome attention, in any Event channel or activity.

8.2 Participants asked to stop harassing behavior must comply immediately. Judges, mentors, sponsors, and Organizers are equally bound by this policy.

8.3 If a participant violates this Code of Conduct, the Organizers may take any action they deem appropriate, including warnings, disqualification, and removal from Event channels and future events.

8.4 To report a concern, contact team@inco.network. Reporters may remain anonymous.

9. Publicity, Media & Data

9.1 You agree that Organizers may record and share content from the Event (including demo videos, screenshots, project descriptions, and public sessions) and may use your name, handle, likeness, and voice as captured in submitted or recorded materials to promote the Event and its outcomes, across any media now known or later developed.

9.2 You agree that Organizers may share your registration details and public profiles (e.g. GitHub, project links) with Event partners and sponsors, and acknowledge that partners may contact you during and after the Event. By participating, you consent to communications from the Organizers and partners about the Event, related products, and future events. You may opt out of marketing communications at any time.

9.3 Any information you choose to share with other participants or partners during the Event is shared at your own discretion and risk. If you wish to keep something confidential, it is your responsibility to protect it.

10. Disclaimers & Limitation of Liability

10.1 The Event, and all tools, SDKs, and materials provided in connection with it, are offered "as is" without warranties of any kind. Onchain interactions carry inherent risk; you are responsible for the security of your wallets, keys, and deployed contracts.

10.2 To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Organizers and their owners, officers, employees, volunteers, agents, and affiliates (the "Releasees") shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, special, or consequential damages, or for any loss of data, funds, or digital assets, arising out of or related to your participation in the Event.

10.3 You assume full responsibility for your participation and, to the fullest extent permitted by law, release and agree not to sue the Releasees for any claim arising out of or related to your participation, whether caused by negligence or otherwise.

10.4 The aggregate limitation of liability set out in the General Terms applies to your participation in the Event. Nothing in this Section is intended to increase Inco's liability beyond that cap.

11. General

11.1 Organizers may modify these Terms or the Event rules from time to time. Changes will be posted and take effect in accordance with the change-and-notice process set out in the General Terms, and your continued participation constitutes acceptance of the updated Terms.

11.2 If any provision of these Terms is held invalid, that provision will apply only to the extent required by law and the remainder will continue in full force and effect.

11.3 These Terms are governed by the laws of the State of Delaware, without regard to conflict-of-laws principles. Any dispute arising out of or relating to these Terms or the Event is subject to the dispute-resolution provisions of the General Terms (including binding arbitration and the class action and jury trial waiver).
