




World Climate Zones Map

An imaginary line drawn around the middle of the Earth with an equal distance between the North Pole and the South Pole.
The four divisions of the year marked by changes in weather patterns and daylight hours.
The conditions in the air above the Earth such as wind, rain or temperature.
The general weather conditions found in a particular place over a long period of time.
