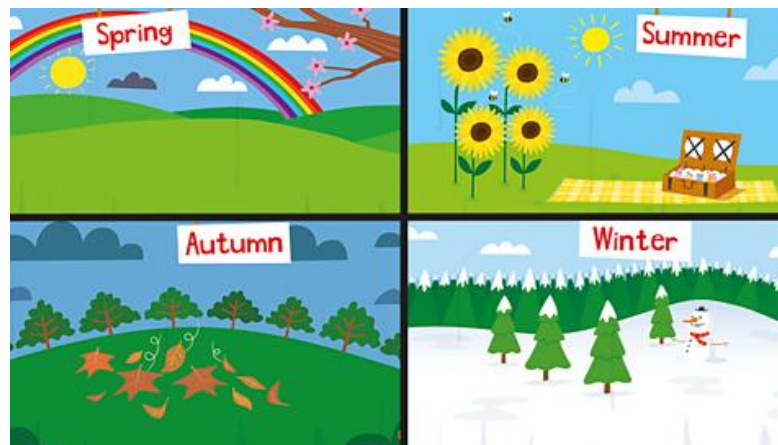
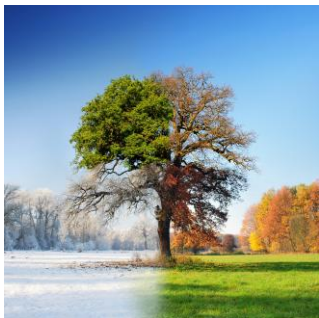

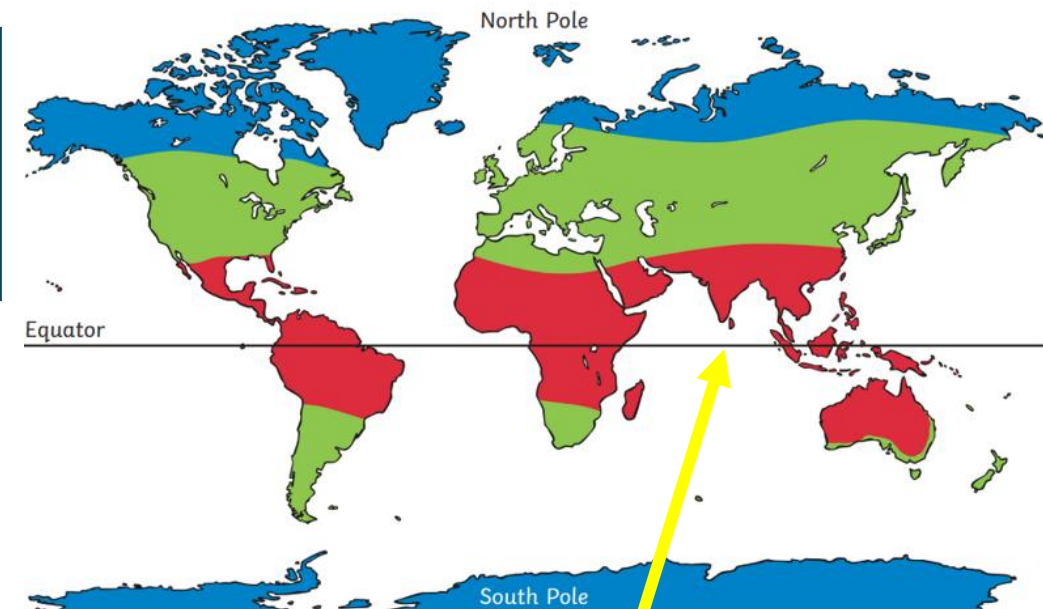
The weather changes in the different seasons.

| Word | Meaning |
|-----------|--|
| World | The Earth and all the people, places and things on it. |
| Country | A large area of land where people live under the same rules. |
| Continent | A very big piece of land on Earth that contains countries. There are seven of them. |
| Poles | The northernmost point of the Earth and the southernmost point of the Earth. |
| Equator | An imaginary line drawn around the middle of the Earth with an equal distance between the North Pole and the South Pole. |
| Season | The four divisions of the year marked by changes in weather patterns and daylight hours. |
| Weather | The conditions in the air above the Earth such as wind, rain or temperature. |
| Climate | The general weather conditions found in a particular place over a long period of time. |
