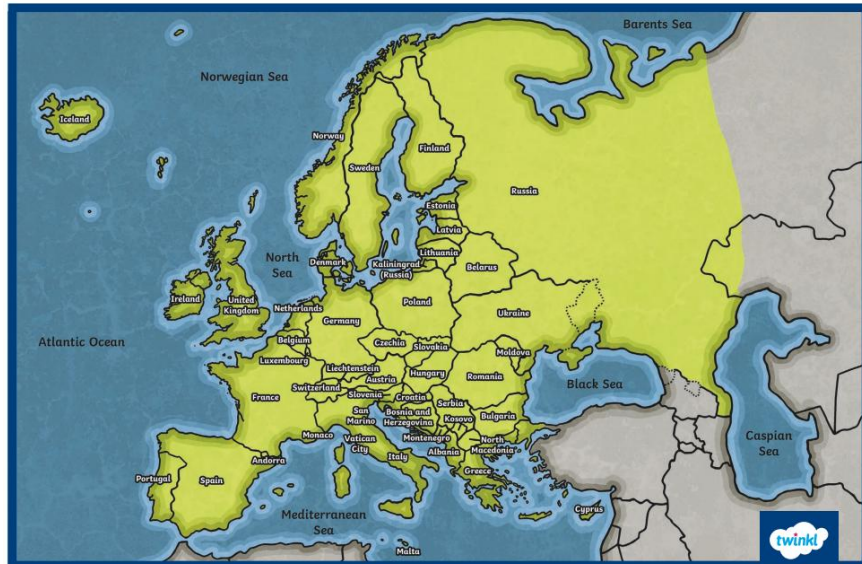

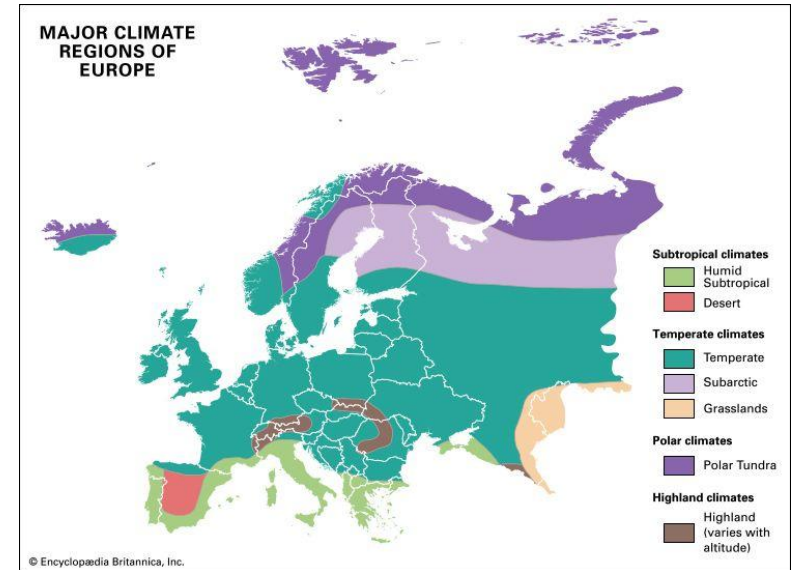

	Key Vocabulary	
	Human feature	Something people have made, like buildings, roads, or bridges.
	Physical feature	Something natural on Earth, like mountains, rivers, or oceans.
	Europe	A big area of land where many countries like France and Italy are. It's one of the places on Earth called a continent.
	Continent	A very big piece of land. There are 7 continents in the world, like Africa and Asia.
	Country	A place with its own name, people, and rules, like Spain or Brazil.
	City	A big place where lots of people live and work, like London or New York.
	Climate	The usual weather in a place, like if it's mostly hot, cold, rainy, or dry.
	Biome	A big area of nature with special plants, animals, and weather, like a rainforest or a desert.
