Face

You may get pimples.

Menstruation

Your period begins.

Height

You get taller.

Breasts

Hair

Hair grows in your armpits, on your legs, and between your legs.

Height

Privates

Your penis and testicles get bigger.

Voice

Your voice deepens.

Lifecycle

Is the different stages of life for a living thing.



Mammal

A warm-blooded vertebrate animal of a class that is distinguished by the possession of hair or fur, females that secrete milk for their young, and typically give birth of live young. .



Gestational period

Foetal development period from the time of conception until birth..



Foetus

An unborn or unhatched offspring of a mammal.



Puberty

Time when the body begins to develop and change as you move from a child to an adult.



Reproduction

The production of offspring by a sexual or asexual process. .
