



The Glockenspiel




We are learning to play the glockenspiel in our Music lessons.

dynamics		how loud or quiet the music is.
timbre		all instruments, including voices, have a certain sound quality e.g. the trumpet has a very different sound quality to the violin.
texture		layers of sound. Layers of sound working together make music very interesting to listen to.
structure	Verso Cherus Verso Chorus Verso	every piece of music has a structure e.g. an introduction, verse and chorus ending.
notation	F A C E	the link between sound and symbol.
