	Live Music	Music made by real people playing or singing.
	Digital Music	Music made or played using technology – like computers, tablets, or apps such as GarageBand.
	Improvise	When a piece, or a part of a piece, of music is made up on the spot.
	Dynamics	The loudness or softness of a piece of music.
	Timbre	The sound quality of a note.
	Notation	The musical symbols when writing music down.
	Pulse	The steady beat in a piece of music (what you might clap along to)
	Texture	The way different layers of sound interact and the overall effect created
