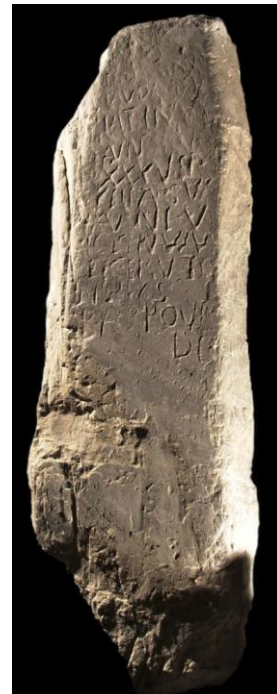

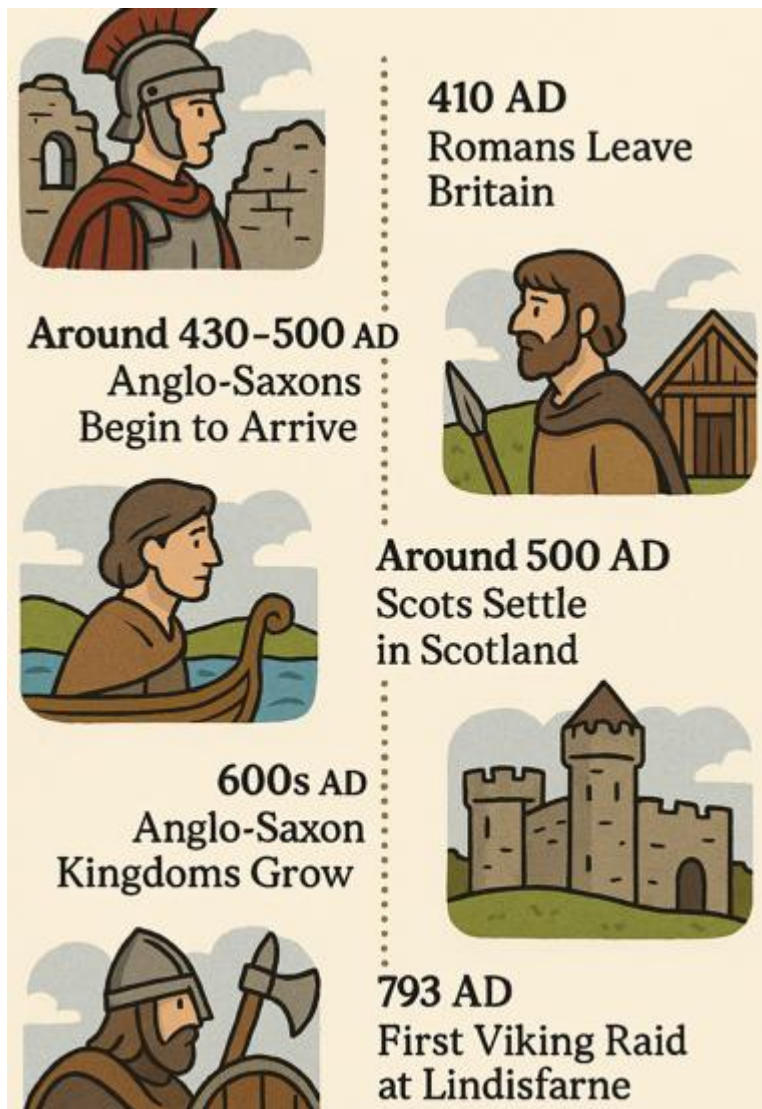

Key Vocabulary		
	Romans	people from a place called Rome, in Italy. A long time ago, they built strong roads, big buildings, and ruled many lands, including parts of Britain.
	Anglo-Saxons	groups of people who came from places like Germany and Denmark.
	Scots	people from Ireland sailed across the sea and settled in the north of Britain. These people were called the Scots, and they helped create the land we now call Scotland.
	Gaelic	Gaelic people lived in Ireland and later moved to parts of Scotland. They had their own customs, stories, and way of life.
	Warrior	a brave fighter who protects their people. Warriors often wore armor and used swords or shields in battles.
	Settle	to move to a new place and make it your home.
	Conflict	when people or groups disagree or fight. It can be a small argument or a big battle.
	Kingdom	land ruled by a king or queen. Long ago, Britain had many small kingdoms with their own rulers.
