



	Empire	An empire is a group of countries or lands ruled by one leader or government.
	Invalidate	To invade means to enter another place with an army to try to take control of it.
	Conquer	To conquer means to defeat another group and take their land.
	Britain	Britain is the island where England, Scotland and Wales are located.
	Latin	Latin is the ancient language that the Romans spoke and wrote.
	Citizen	A citizen is a person who belongs to a country and has certain rights there.
	Legacy	A legacy is something important that people from the past have left behind for us.
