

<p>Film (N)</p>		<p>A motion picture or a movie.</p>
<p>Film (V)</p>		<p>To photograph with a movie camera or other video recording device.</p>
<p>iMovie</p>		<p>An app used to turn photos and videos clips into movies or trailers to share with others.</p>
<p>Record</p>		<p>To use a mechanical or electrical device to view something later.</p>
<p>Storyboard</p>		<p>A page of drawings presenting a sequence of images as they will appear in a video presentation, film, or advertisement.</p>
<p>Trim</p>		<p>To make something neat by cutting or clipping away some parts.</p>
<p>Split</p>		<p>To divide into parts or separate into new lengths.</p>
<p>Undo</p>		<p>Reverse the previous action.</p>
<p>Reorder</p>		<p>To rearrange into a correct or more efficient order.</p>
