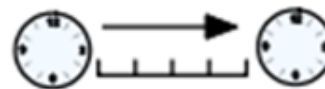

Chronology



Chronology means putting events in the order they happened, from first to last. It helps us understand what happened before, what happened next, and what happened after.

Differences between old and modern (new) toys

Old toys were often made of wood.



Modern (new) toys are often made of plastic.



Old toys were mechanical or moved by hand.



Modern (new) toys use batteries or electric.



Old toys were usually made by hand.













Modern (new) toys are usually made by machines.

Old-fashioned		Something from the past that is not used much now.
Modern		Something new, up to date, and used by people now.
Tradition		Something people do again and again over many years.
Celebration		A happy event for marking something special together.
Entertainment		Things that make people happy, amused, or interested.
Past		The past is everything that has already happened. It could be yesterday, last week, or even hundreds of years ago.
Present		Something that is happening now.
Future		Something that might happen in the future. It could happen tomorrow, next week or many years.
Chronology		Putting events in the order that they happened.
Timeline		A timeline is a line that shows events in the order they happened. It helps us see what came first, what happened next, and what happened last.
