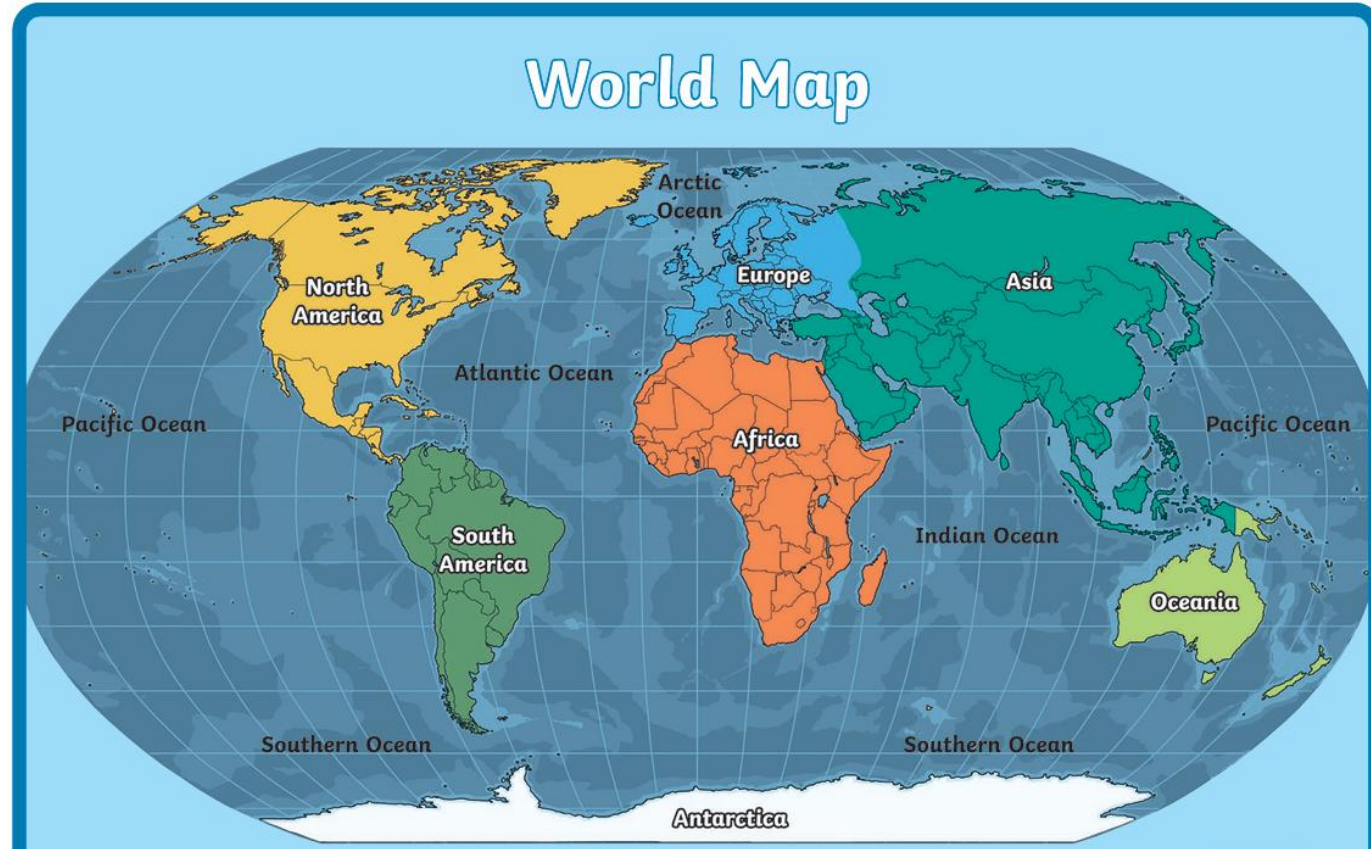

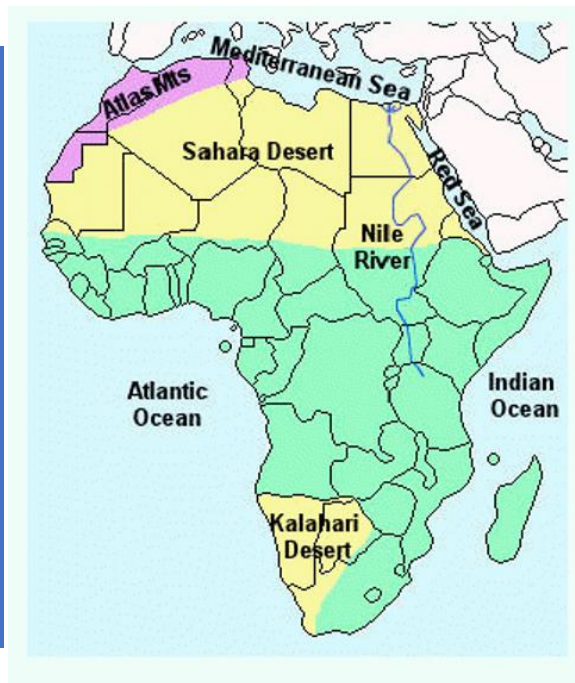


There are five oceans in the world.

	Ocean	An ocean is a huge body of salt water. There are 5 oceans on Earth.
	Sea	A sea is a smaller part of the ocean that appears where the ocean meets land.
	The UK	The UK is a group of countries: England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.
	Africa	Africa is a continent. It is a ground of more than 50 countries.
	River	A river is a flowing stream of water that leads to the sea, a lake or another river.
	Lake	A lake is a large body of water that is surrounded by land.
