1. WHO WE ARE

This website and the REVELTRY mobile app are operated by Wondr Technologies UK Limited (company number 16979480) ("we", "us" or "our"). We are a private limited company and for more information click [here](#) .

2. OUR WEBSITE

This cookie policy only relates to your use of our website ("Platform"). Through out our Platform we may link to other websites owned and operated by certain trusted third parties. These other third-party websites may also use cookies or similar technologies in accordance with their own separate policies. We use the following cookies:

i. Strictly necessary cookies

These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services. These are processed on the basis of our legitimate interests in operating and securing our website.

ii. Analytical/performance cookies

These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

iii. Functionality cookies

- Any tracking within the mobile application, if implemented in the future, will be conducted through standard mobile technologies such as device identifiers or analytics SDKs, which will be addressed within the Privacy Policy rather than the Cookie Policy.
