



Drainage Rates and Special Levies for 2022-2023

As required by Section 48 (2) of the Land Drainage Act 1991, the Board gives notice as follows:

1. On 17 January 2022, the Board made:

A Drainage Rate of 7.38 (Seven point Three Eight) in the pound (£) in respect of agricultural land and/or buildings in their district to raise £104,767.34 of their expenditure for the financial year ending on 31 March 2023.

2. Also, on 17 January 2022, the Board made a Special Levy of £94,615.59 on

Drainage Rates and Special Levies for 2022/2023: From 1 April 2022 to 31 March 2023

On the day of 17 January 2022, the Board resolved as follows:

1. That in respect of the financial year ending 31 March (Year) the proportions of expenditure to be raised by drainage rates with regard to agricultural land or buildings and by special levies on local authorities is 9.66% (£10,115.75) and 90.38% (£94,615.59) respectively.
2. That the proportions between the local billing authorities of the amount to be raised by special levies are as set out below, against the special levy for each local billing authority.
3. To make the drainage rates and special levies set out below.


