Washington Mass Timber Accelerator (MASSTAC) is working to make Washington a leader in low-carbon, high quality construction through increased utilization of locally manufactured mass timber.

OUR MISSION

Sustainably and equitably accelerating the adoption of mass timber in construction, in Washington and nationally.

OUR VISION

Washington's robust mass timber value chain is enabling cleaner, faster, safer construction and healthier, more beautiful buildings in Washington and beyond.

WHO WE ARE

The Washington Mass Timber Accelerator (colloquially, MASSTAC) is working to make Washington a leader in low carbon, high quality construction through increased utilization of locally manufactured mass timber. With representation from industry, state and local government, Tribal nations, labor organizations, and forestry, we are the central hub of mass timber activity in the State of Washington.

WHAT WE DO

1. **PROMOTION:** Raise awareness of mass timber as a sustainable and efficient building material, highlighting the abundant forest resources, and the design and manufacturing leadership of Washington businesses.
2. **PROGRESSIVE CODES:** Spearhead the development of building code proposals that facilitate the use of mass timber in construction.
3. **STRATEGIC INITIATIVES:** Strategic initiatives to address the key barriers to mainstream adoption of mass timber in construction: cost premium, learning curve, insurance availability, carbon accounting, supply stalemate, and market confidence.

FOCUS AREAS

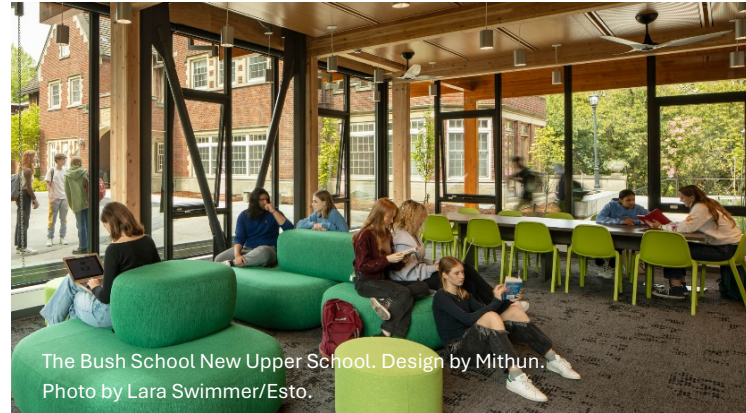
1. **HOUSING:** Highlighting opportunities for mass timber to address the housing shortage in WA.
2. **SCHOOLS:** Making mass timber the default choice for building new K-12 schools in WA.
3. **MANUFACTURING:** Supporting investment in local manufacturing of high-tech, low-carbon products

YEAR ONE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Since our founding in July 2024, MASSTAC has already had an impact:

SCHOOLS

- Producing a **Mass Timber Schools Short Film** highlighting mass timber's transformative potential for school construction.
- Organizing a 1-day **Mass Timber Schools Symposium** for representatives of Washington's school districts, school boards, and PTAs, to be held in Olympia this fall.



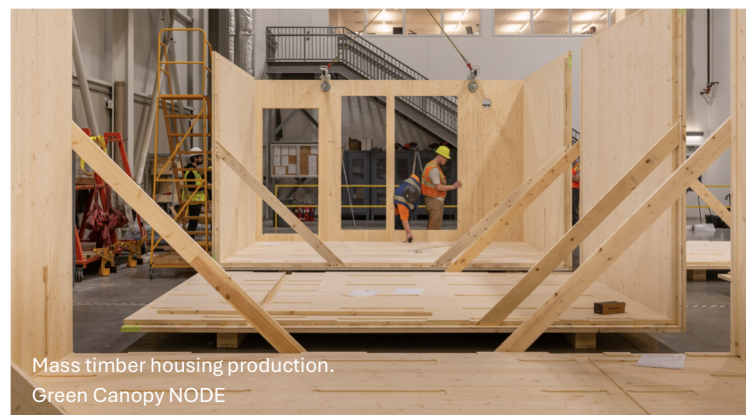
HOUSING

- Produced print and digital versions of the **Mass Timber Housing Opportunities book**, which showcases mass timber housing at all scales, from single detached houses to skyscrapers.
- Produced multiple proposals to the Washington State Building Code Council that facilitate the use of mass timber in housing, including an **Embodied Carbon Appendix**, which establishes methods to measure and reduce embodied carbon emissions associated with building materials and operations. This appendix is critical for mass timber, as it raises the bar for new construction and incentivizes the use of mass timber in construction.



MANUFACTURING

- Co-produced **Washington Forest Products Day in Olympia** on April 9, 2025, to inform policymakers about the valuable contributions of Washington's mass timber manufacturers.
- Launched the **MASSTAC website** - <http://wamasstimber.org> - which includes a comprehensive database of Washington's mass timber manufacturers, industry events, and industry resources - averages 250 visitors per month.

With your help, we can continue advancing the use of mass timber in construction as a natural climate change solution, a means of supporting forest ecosystem health, and a strategy for healthier buildings.

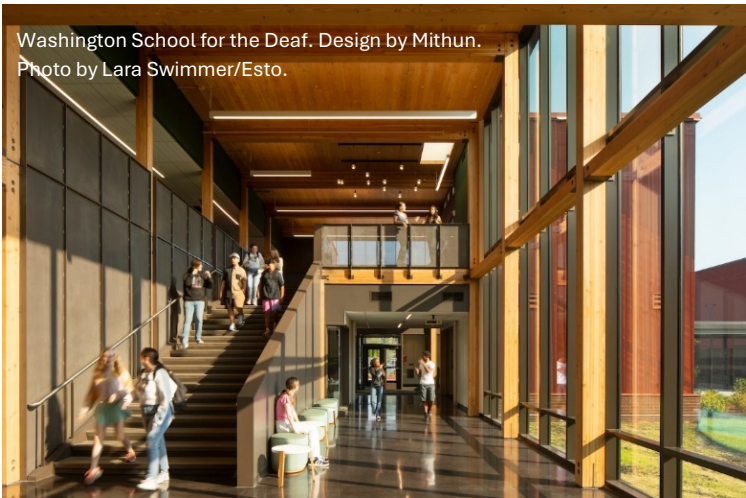
