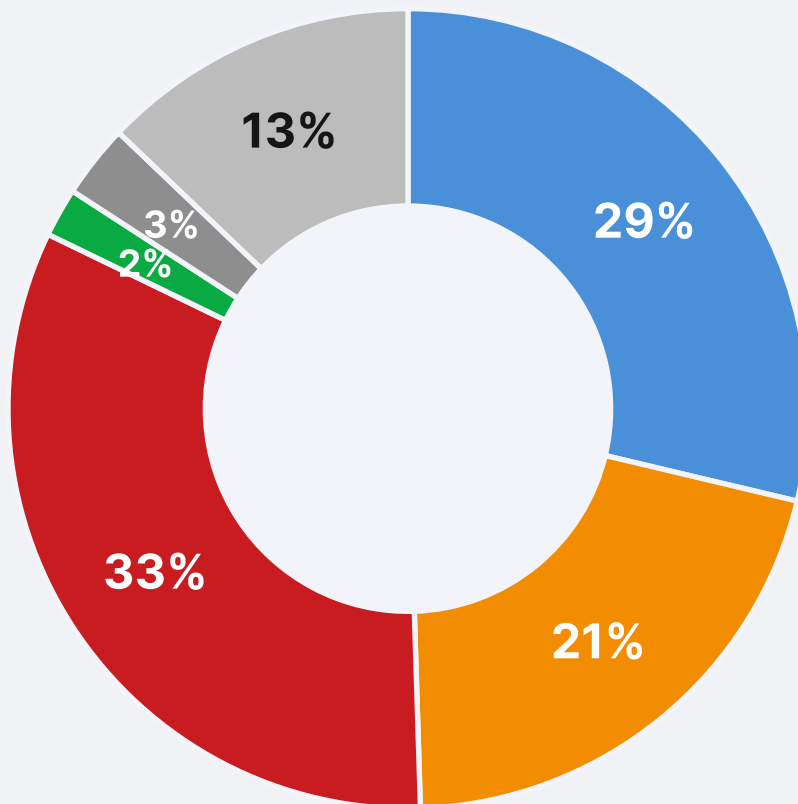
Methodology

Liaison surveyed a random sample of 1,000 Ontarians from July 20th to July 21st, 2026, using Interactive Voice Recording (IVR) technology. To ensure a representative sample, participants were reached through random digit dialing (RDD) across both landline and cellular phone networks. The resulting data was weighted to match targets based on the 2021 Census. For the total sample, the margin of error is ± 3.1 percentage points, 19 times out of 20, though this margin is higher for sub-samples. Additionally, results may not add up to 100% due to rounding.

If a Provincial Election were held today, which party would you vote for?



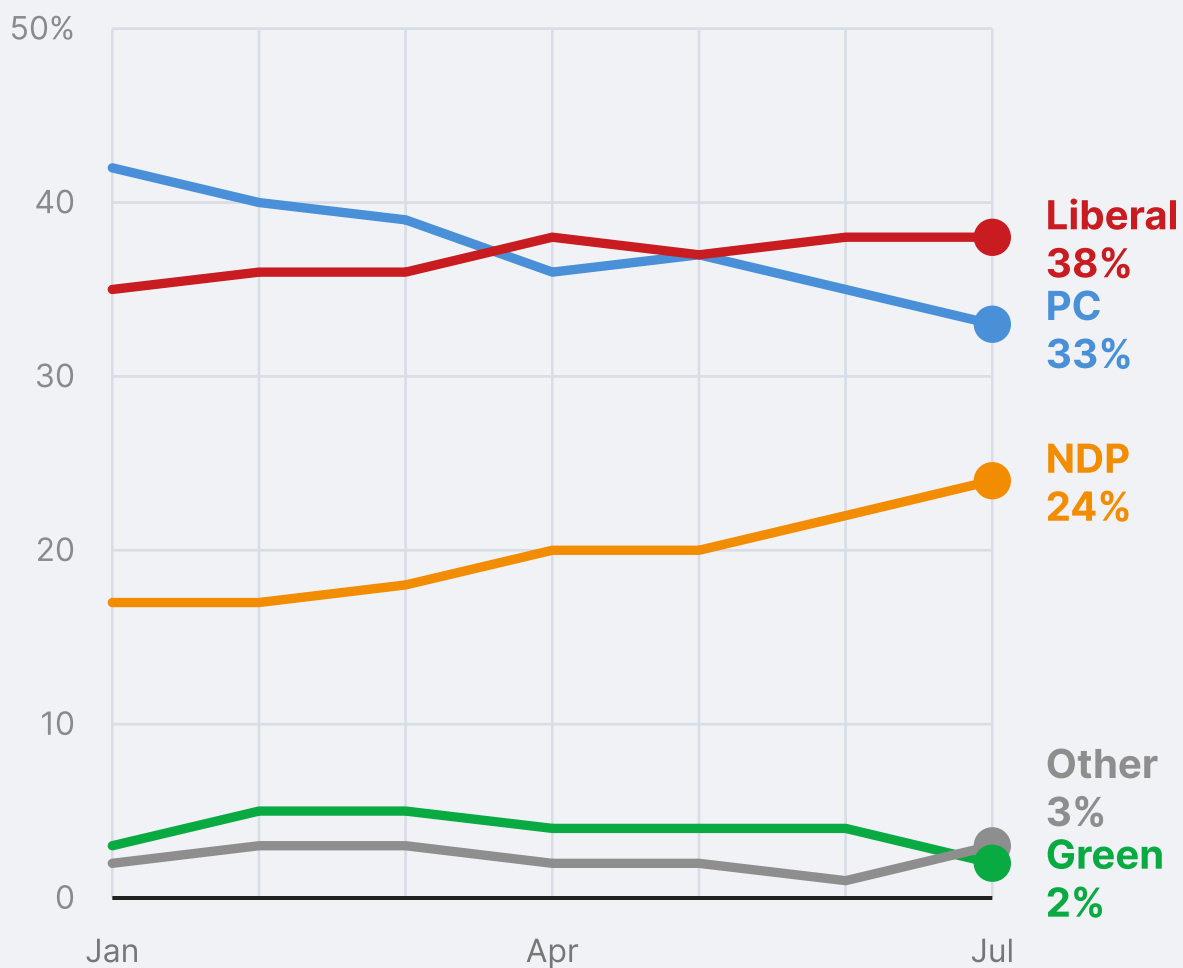
■ PC ■ ONDP ■ OLP ■ Green ■ Other ■ Undecided

Decided and Leaning



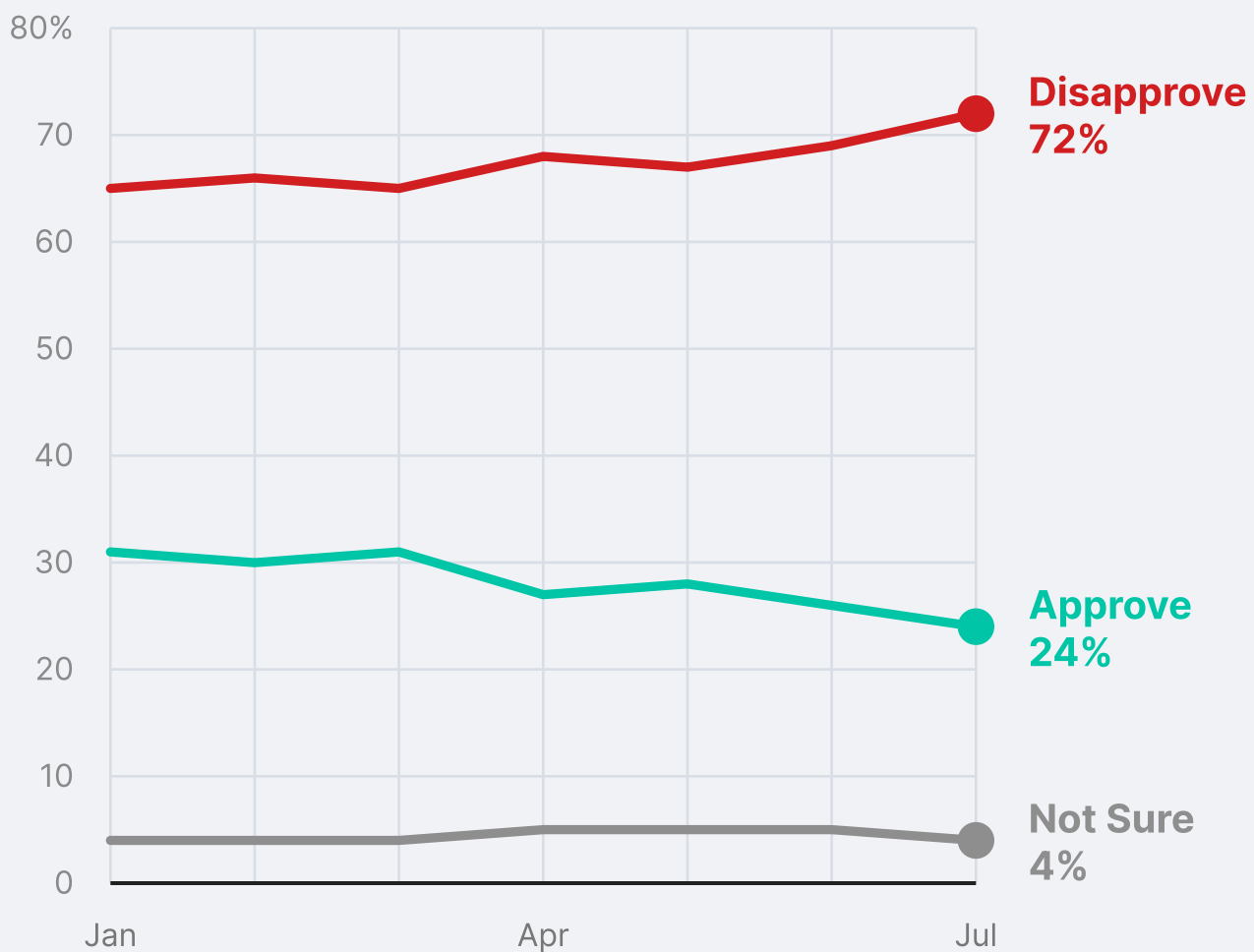
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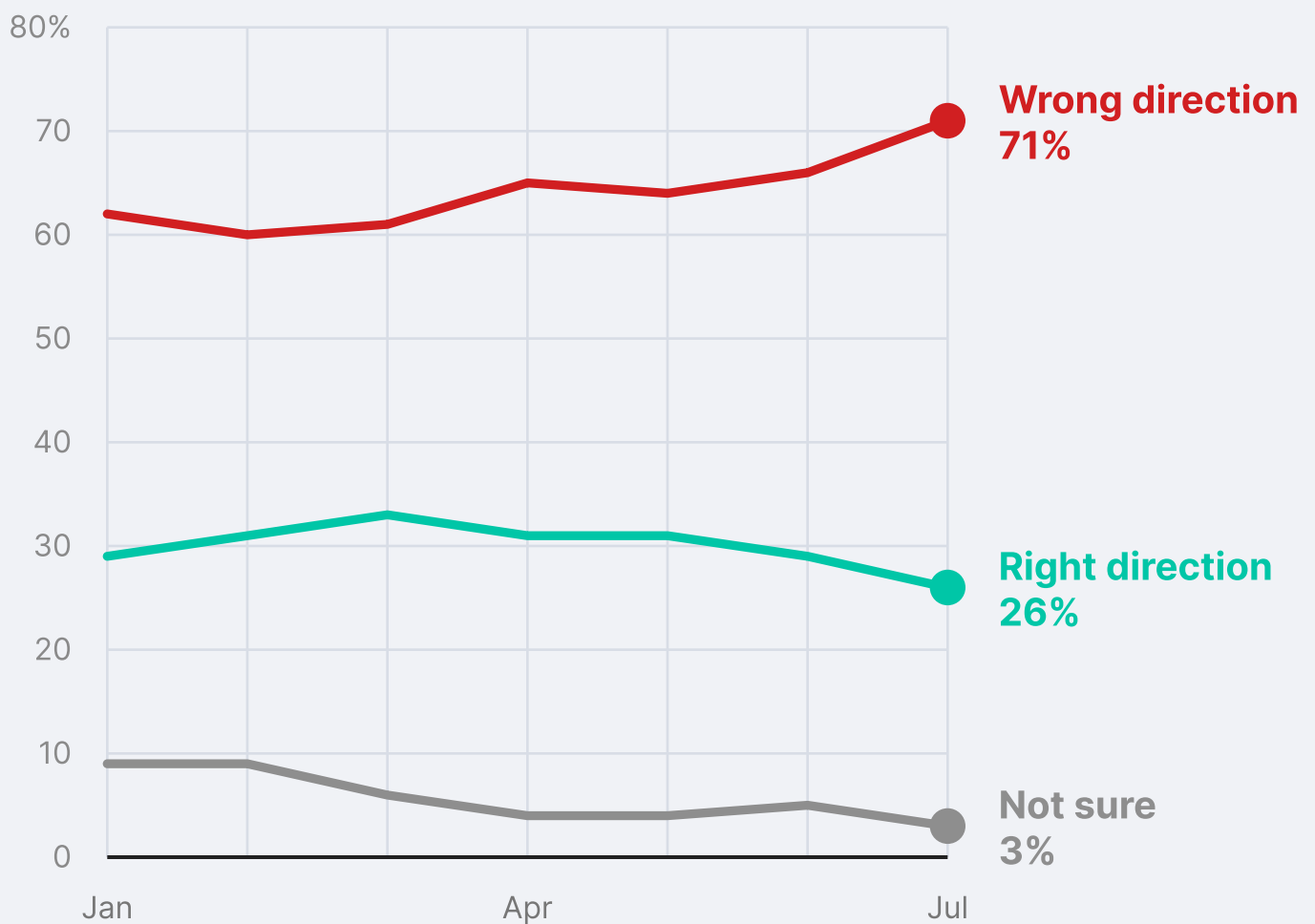
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Do you approve or disapprove of the job Doug Ford is doing as Premier of Ontario?



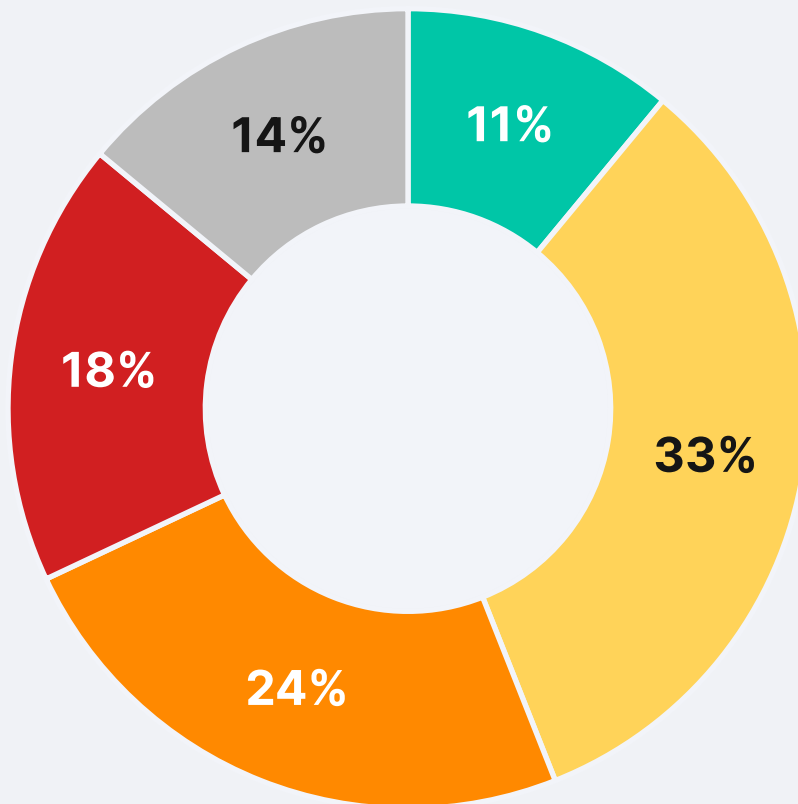
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Would you say that the province of Ontario is generally heading in the right direction, or the wrong direction?



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Overall, do you support or oppose allowing more large data centres to be built in Ontario?

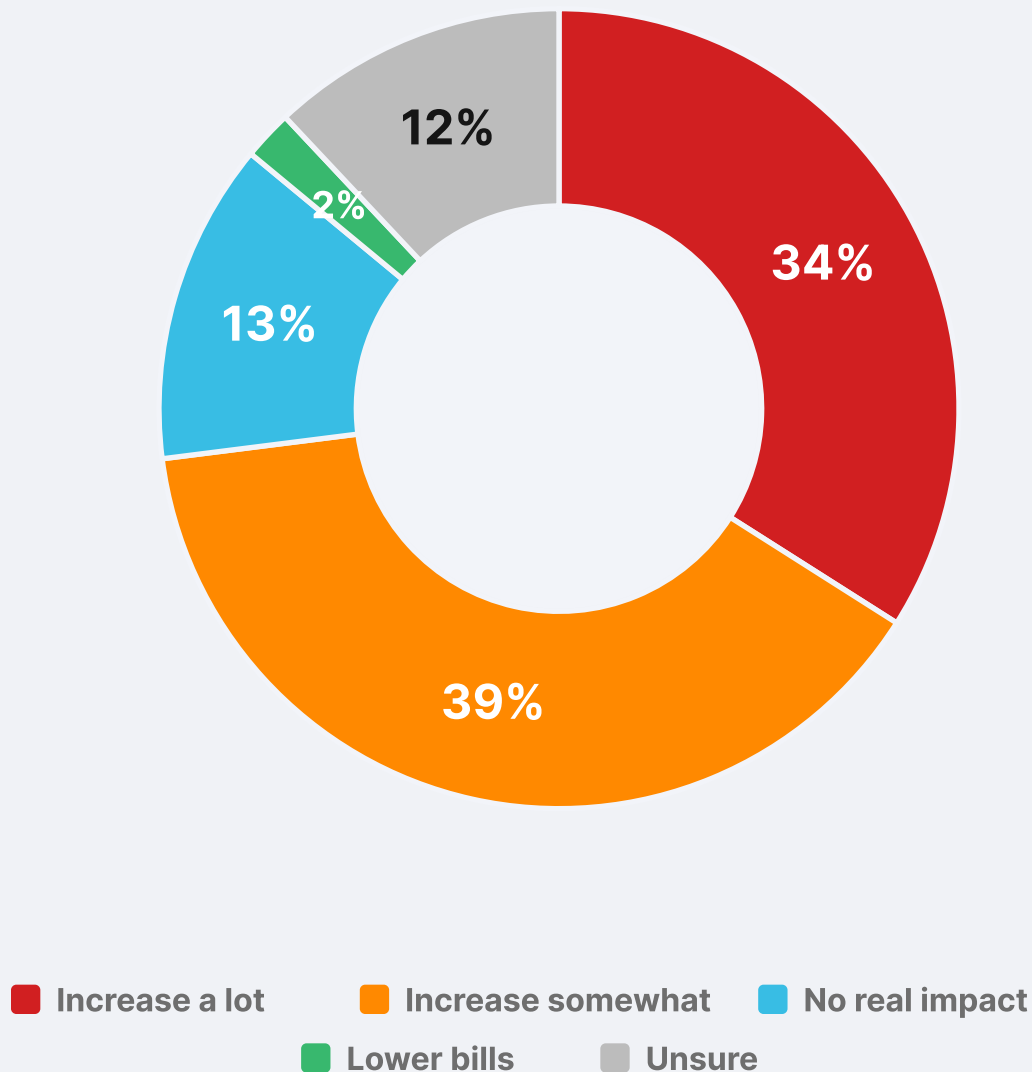

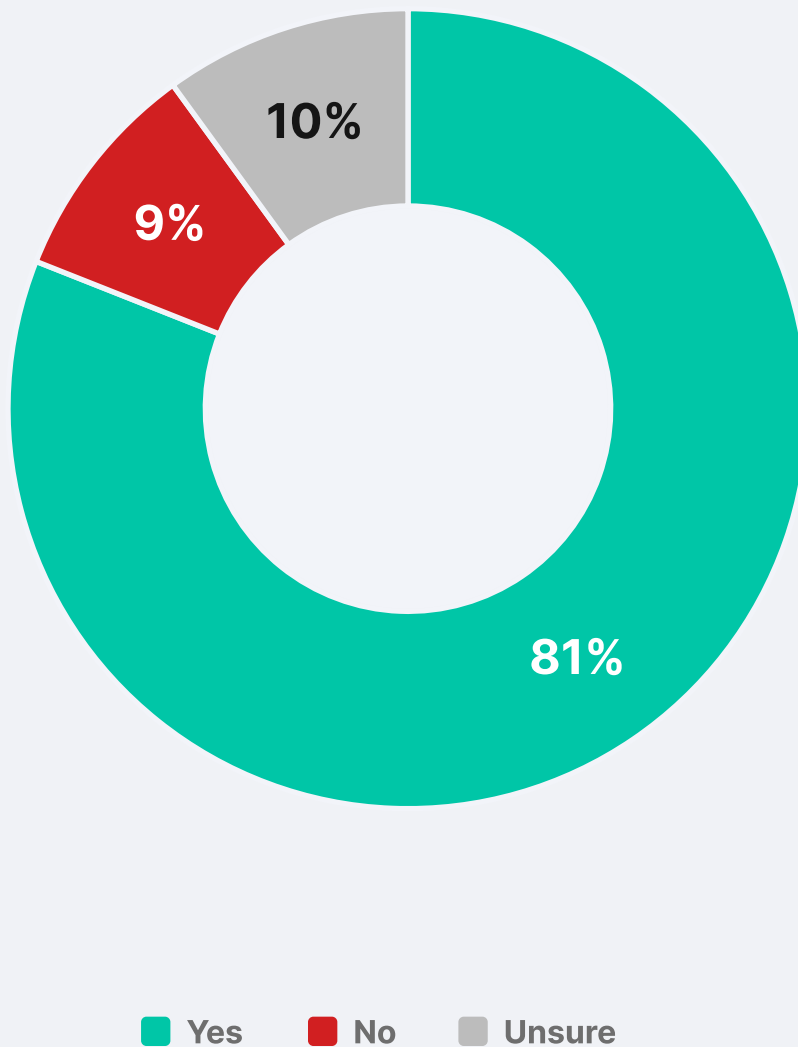
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Do you think more large data centres in Ontario would increase household electricity bills, lower household electricity bills, or have no real impact?



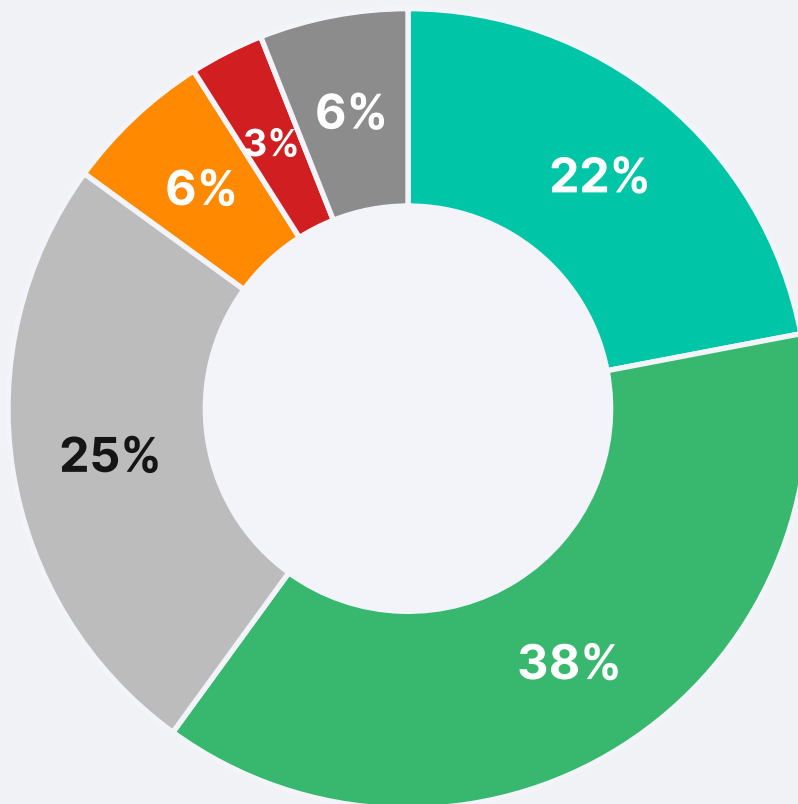
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Should data-centre companies be required to pay for any new electricity generation, transmission lines, or local grid upgrades needed to serve them?



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Would you be more likely or less likely to support a large data centre if it helped keep Canadian data stored in Canada?

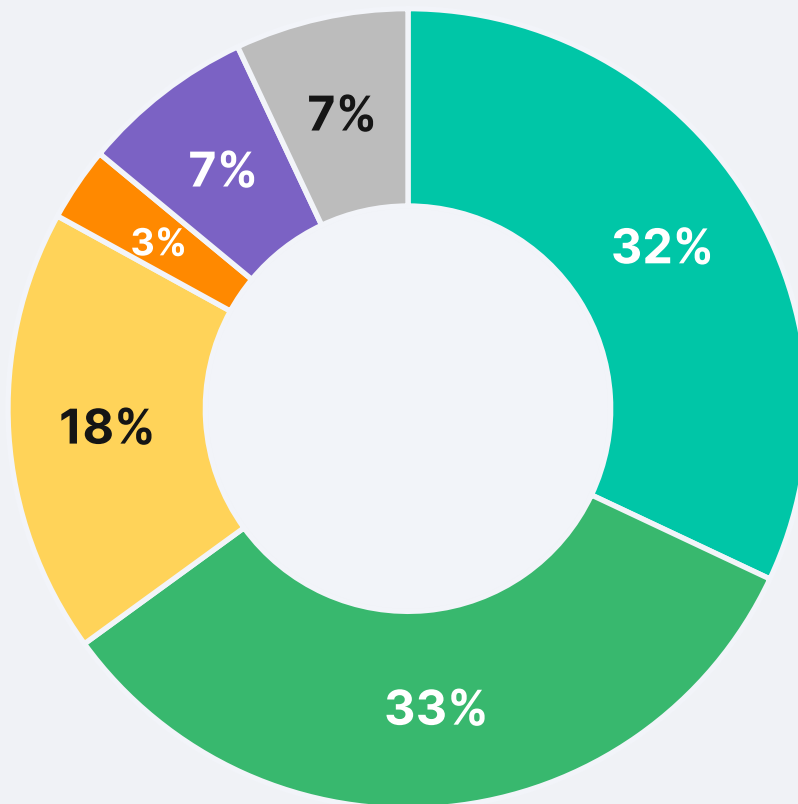

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If Ontario has to choose which projects get priority access to new electricity, which should come first?

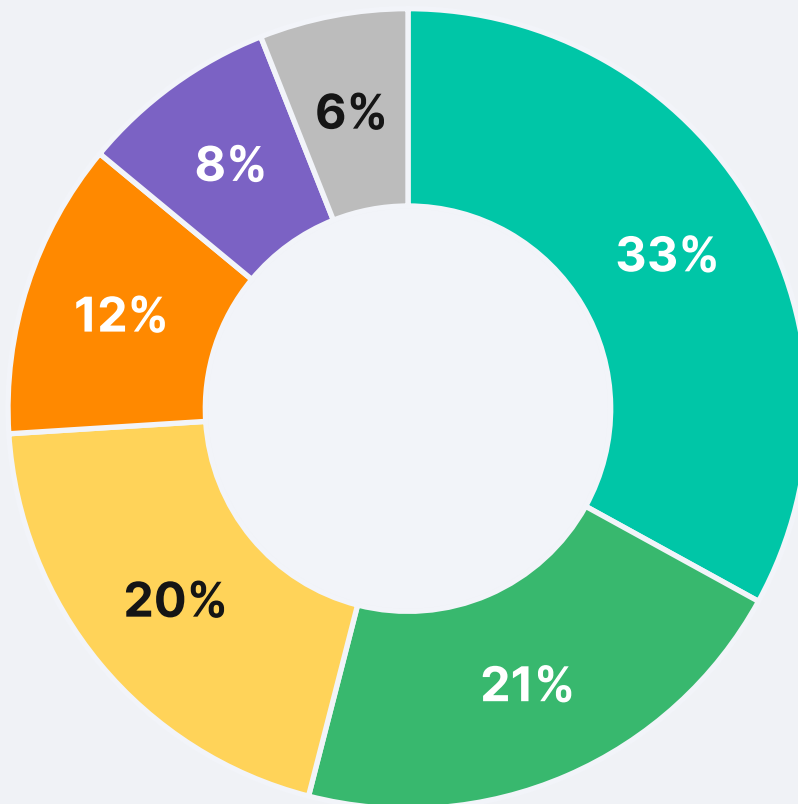
