

# TORONTO

Toronto Survey for the National Ethnic Press and Media Council of Canada

Field Dates: May 5-6, 2023

Release Date: May 10, 2023 (Issues)





Liaison surveyed a random sample of 1,257 Torontonians through Interactive Voice Recording (IVR) from May 5 to May 6, 2023.

Respondents were screened for voter eligibility.

Responses were weighted using demographic and geographic information to targets based on the 2021 Census.

The margin of error for survey results is  $\pm$  2.76 percentage points, 19 times out of 20 for the total.

Results may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

Caution: low sample sizes for Furey and Perruzza cross tabs.






It was established in Toronto in the 1970s by Thomas Saras who is also the President and CEO of the National Ethnic Press and Media Council of Canada.



Q: Do you support or oppose building more housing in the City of Toronto?














Q: And do you support or oppose maintaining the characteristics of neighbourhoods in Toronto?














Q: In your opinion, what is more important: building more housing in the city of Toronto or maintaining the characteristics of neighbourhoods in Toronto? Or is neither issue important?








Q: In your opinion, what is more important: building more housing in the city of Toronto or maintaining the characteristics of neighbourhoods in Toronto? Or is neither issue important?








Q: Do you support or oppose building more housing by reducing parking requirements for new developments?














Q: Do you support or oppose building more housing by allowing larger developments near transit corridors?














Q: Do you support or oppose building more housing by allowing apartments and condos on land currently zoned for single family homes?








