Class Descriptions

Obedience Level 1 (Beginner)

In this class you will learn to teach your dog all the basic, fundamental commands. Sit, down, stand, stay, coming when called, jumping up, and pack leader exercises. While building a bond of trust and respect. This class is open to 8-week-old puppies and beyond. You can teach dogs of every age new tricks.

Included with class:

- Homework sheets
- Leash
- Training collar

Cost: \$200 per class

Advanced Obedience

This class is for dogs that already have the basics commands covered. This includes sit, down, stand, stay, coming when called, walking on a loose, and heel position. We start to introduce distractions, more distance, and off leash exercises.

Cost: \$185 per class

Puppy Principles

This class is geared towards all our puppies 9 months or younger. Learn all the basic commands while also building confidence. Additionally, teaching you what to do when your puppy is biting, jumping, going to the bathroom in the house, how to handle crate training.

Competition Obedience

For everyone interested in competing with your dog in Obedience or Rally. Fine tune your handling skills and expecting the most from your dog.

Rally

Rally obedience (Rally-O) is a fun, team-based sport where handler and dog navigate a course of 10-20 numbered stations, performing obedience tasks like sits, turns, downs, and other fun at every sign. Unlike traditional obedience, it features a more relaxed, encouraging atmosphere where you are encouraged to engage and talk with your dog.
