

El Velado (2023)

El Velado is a beautiful and very old vineyard situated at an altitude of 600 metres above sea level. It is the first vineyard we fell in love with in Lanciego and the one that probably best expresses the influence of the light.

The vineyard was planted in the easternmost part of the village, facing mainly west and south, and enjoying a warmer light. Because of this exposure, its field blend is made with a majority of Garnacha and Tempranillo plus some other old varieties, including white. Its old age of over 80 years, its size, and the sculptural shape of the bush pruned vines, make this vineyard very special and full of light.

VINTAGE CHARACTERISTICS

The season was defined by unpredictable water availability and well-balanced ripening.

After a dry start, June rains ensured that the vines had the necessary water reserves to face a warm, dry summer that accelerated sugar concentration. Gentle, welcome rain fell in the last stage of the growth cycle, allowing the grapes to ripen fully, and preserving the classic acidity and freshness of Garnacha. The harvest took place on the 7th of October.
