

La Estrada (2023)

La Estrada Alta is a tiny vineyard of only 0.64 ha, at 610 metres above sea level. It is located in the higher and most western part of the village of Lanciego, on very poor soil. Planted in the 1940's and managed with traditional bush pruning, it was mostly field blended with Tempranillo and a little Graciano.

Facing northeast, the vineyard is situated on top of a slope of pure chalk clay. This special vineyard with its small production has always fascinated us for its depth and balance.

VINTAGE CHARACTERISTICS

2023 was a warm and dry year, with early budbreak and slow ripening. June rains provided water reserves and boosted vegetative growth, however in August, the vines suffered from heatwaves. Due to La Estrada's altitude, we had to wait until the 6th of October for the skins of this particular Tempranillo to reach full ripeness.
