

Implementing Tier III Interventions and Supports Overview

Description: The *Implementing Tier III Interventions and Supports* professional learning consists of three parts: one brief online presentation and activity to be completed as pre-work, one full day in-person professional learning session, and a follow-up component designed with each district coordinator to meet district-specific needs. Participants are strongly encouraged to attend the *Implementing Tier II Interventions and Supports* professional learning sessions prior to completing the *Implementing Tier III Interventions and Supports* professional learning sessions. The Tier III sessions are designed to help support system-level practices that are established as part of the Tier II sessions. Having these systems in place first allows teams to make informed decisions on how to best adjust and intensify support.

Evaluate the degree to which the essential features of academically and behaviorally aligned Tier III supports are implemented at their school. 2. Design the components of an intervention plan for a student with intensive needs so it reflects the features and recommended practices of Tier III. 3. Use data within a structured problem-solving process to adapt interventions so that supports at all tiers can be used to address student needs. 4. Evaluate existing Tier II and Tier III systems and supports to create an initial action plan to improve practices and reduce or remove system-level barriers. <p>Participants will leave this session with an action plan focused on improving RTI²-A+B and Tier III at their school.</p>
