Before moving day

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| ☐ Ask friends or family for help, or book a truck/moving service. | ☐ Confirm the practical details: the move-in date and time provided by your property manager, as well as your apartment's address and number. |
| ☐ Update your address (school, bank, employer, etc.). | ☐ Use the Service québécois de changement d'adresse to notify the Régie de l'assurance maladie du Québec (RAMQ), the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec (SAAQ), and Revenu Québec. |
| ☐ Set up mail forwarding with Canada Post if needed. | ☐ Prepare packing supplies: boxes, packing tape, and markers. |
| ☐ Get tenant insurance | ☐ Cancel or transfer your current lease if you were already renting. |
| ☐ Sort your belongings: bring what you need, donate or recycle the rest. | ☐ Plan your furniture using the apartment floor plan provided. |
| ☐ Request a day off work, if applicable. | |
