4. Petitioner was thus left with no choice other than to initiate this legal action to enforce its right to complete responses, and to enforce Respondent Regents' obligation to provide complete responses.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- 5. This Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Section 10 of Article VI of the California Constitution, Code of Civil Procedure Sections 1085 and 1060, California Government Code Sections 7923.000 through 7923.115, and California Education Code Section 92957.
- 6. Venue is proper in this Court as the public records at issue are located within the County of Yolo, and events giving rise to the claims occurred in the County of Yolo.

PARTIES

- 7. Petitioner Sixth Night Coalition is an unincorporated association, most of whose members reside in the County of Yolo. Sixth Night Coalition operates/has operated under the name Stop Davis Antisemitism and used the related email address of stopdavisantisemitism@gmail.com. It has also used the email alias of davisoctober7th@gmail.com.
- 8. Respondent Regents of the University of California form a corporation which administers the University of California, a public trust. Regents are vested with the legal title to, and the management and disposition of, the property of the University of California, and are the legal custodian of the records at issue in this lawsuit. Regents possesses the power to sue and be sued on behalf of the University of California. Cal. Const. Art. 9, § 9.
- 9. At all relevant times hereto, Regents have been a "state agency" as that term is defined in California Government Code Section 7920.540.
- 10. Regents maintain their primary administrative offices at 1111 Franklin Street, 12th Floor, Oakland, CA 94607, and the Office of The General Counsel of The Regents has offices at 1111 Franklin Street, 8th Floor, Oakland, California 94607. Regents are a legal resident of Alameda County, California, and are amenable to service of process in Alameda County.
- 11. Sixth Night Coalition is a member of the public under the PRA, Cal. Gov. Code section 7920.520.

12. Sixth Night Coalition is beneficially interested in the outcome of these proceedings and has a clear, present, and substantial right to the relief sought herein and has no adequate remedy at law apart from that sought in this petition.

DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS UNDER THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC RECORDS ACT

- 13. The State of California enacted its Public Records Act for the explicit purpose of increasing freedom of information by giving the public access to information in possession of public agencies. *See CBS, Inc. v. Block*, 42 Cal 3d. 646,651 (1986). The California legislature proclaimed that "[i]mplicit in the democratic process is the notion that government should be accountable for its actions. In order to verify accountability," the legislature continued, the public "must have access to government files. Such access permits checks against the arbitrary exercise of official power and secrecy in the political process." *CBS*, 42 Cal.3d at 651.
- 14. The PRA requires that all records "containing information relating to the conduct of the public's business prepared, owned, used, or retained by any state or local agency" must be made publicly available for inspection and copying upon request, unless those records are exempt from disclosure. Cal. Gov. Code §§ 7922.525(a)-(b); 7920.530. If a respondent claims that some documents are exempt from disclosure, it must disclose all non-exempt material. Cal. Gov. Code § 792.525.
- 15. "All public records are subject to disclosure unless the Legislature has expressly provided to the contrary." *Sierra Club v Superior Court*, 57 Cal.4th 157, 165-66 (2013).
- 16. If a respondent claims that any request is completely or partially denied, that claim must be in writing and must set forth the names and titles or position of each person responsible for the denial. Cal. Gov. Code §§ 7922.540 (a)-(b).
- 17. The California Constitution also guarantees that the records of public agencies be open to the public. Laws such as the PRA and education code must be "broadly construed" if it furthers the people's right to access and "narrowly construed" if it limits the right of access. Cal. Const. Art. 1, § 3(b)(2).

18. Should the PRA requestor prevail in litigation, "the court shall award court costs and attorney fees to the requestor." Cal. Gov. Code § 7923.115(a).

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

- 19. University of California, Davis ("UC Davis"), is a branch of the University of California and is managed, administered and controlled by Respondent Regents. For convenience and specificity, this pleading refers to events occurring on the campus there and refers to faculty and staff for this branch as "UC Davis"; but as stated, Respondent Regents are responsible for all actions attributed herein to UC Davis, and Regents are the custodian of the records at issue in this lawsuit.
- 20. Since Hamas' October 7, 2023, attack on Israel during which hundreds of Hamas terrorists and other Gazans slaughtered, dismembered and tortured, raped, and kidnapped hundreds of Israelis, the UC Davis campus has been afflicted by open advocacy of violence and disruptive, harassing, and sometimes violent conduct particularly targeting Jews and Israelis. In most cases, UC Davis ignored this conduct, and in some cases UC Davis or its officers, staff, and teaching staff actively fostered and/or participated in it.
- 21. Examples of the advocacy of violence, and disruptive, harassing, and violent behavior, include:
 - a. On October 10, 2023—a mere three days after Hamas perpetrated the worst slaughter of Jews since the Holocaust—UC Davis Assistant Professor Jemma DeCristo tweeted a threat against "Zionist journalists" on her X account (handle @jemmaisOKeh). Her post stated: "one group of ppl we have easy access to in the US is all these zionist journalists who spread propaganda and misinformation...they have houses with addresses, kids in school... they can fear their bosses, but they should fear us more," accompanied by a knife emoji, an axe emoji, and three blood drop emojis.
 - b. On December 23, 2023, Associated Students of UC Davis (ASUCD) Internal Vice President Aaminah Muhammad (ucdvicepresident)—a UC Davis student who is paid by UC Davis for her work as ASUCD IVP—reposted a call for death and violence against Zionists and a celebration of Hamas' humiliation of an Israeli hostage that Batool Mohammed, vice president of UC Davis' chapter of Students for Justice in Palestine ("SJP"), posted to Instagram the same date. The post included "i don't care about them [zionists]! i wake up daily and pray for their d3@th and pray for their forever sentencing to hell. zionists are visious they are evil. they are not people they are not humans, they are devils wallah." Mohammad's post also supported terrorism: "i wholeheartedly with everything in me support every armed palestinian resistance group."

- c. During the May 10, 2024 graduation ceremony for UC Davis School of Law, several graduating law school students spoiled the event for Jews and Israelis, and others, by exploiting the forum to advocate for Hamas and the Palestinians and against Israel. Quite a few students sported keffiyehs over their gowns, displayed Palestinian flags, signs such as "From the river to the sea" and "Resistance until victory," and the inverted red triangle Hamas uses to target and threaten attack. University officials did nothing to prevent or stop the ceremony's politicization.
- d. Between May 12 and May 18, 2024, there was an encampment on UC Davis Quad featuring anti-Israel graffiti, graffiti with terrorist group symbols, and signs with violent rhetoric posted around the "walls" of the encampment. A Jewish professor was physically obstructed from entering near the encampment to hear a talk. A Jewish community member giving a walking tour of UC Davis to a transfer student and her family were approached by a man with an oversized umbrella who shoved the umbrella into one of their faces, and hurled a variety of profanities and obscenities at them. Certain UC Davis faculty members actively supported the encampment, including conducting classes within this hostile-to-Jews area.
- The university allowed groups of masked individuals to invade classrooms e. and disrupt classes on May 27 and 28, 2024. The disrupters used drums and bullhorns, shouted that those present were complicit in "genocide", chanted pro-Palestine chants, and carried signs. Campus police did not intervene. In one of the disrupted classes, a Jewish student (a descendant of Holocaust survivors) with an anxiety disorder suffered a panic attack when a mob of masked, screaming/chanting individuals broke into his classroom and stopped directly in front of him. Having a fight-or-flight reflex, he threw a water bottle at the invaders. Incredibly, UC Davis then investigated the Jewish victim for misconduct, although in the end it did not press charges. Additionally, the student was harassed by other students. The university also referred him to counseling, and did the same for other Jews who complained about the classroom invasions. To the best of our clients' knowledge, not a single classroom invader has faced any adverse consequences for their actions on May 27-28.
- f. On October 7, 2024, exactly one year after the October 7, 2023 massacre, protestors (many with completely covered faces) disrupted classes and other events at the Memorial Union by marching through the building while chanting anti-Israel, anti-Zionist slogans with a drum and a loudspeaker/sound system. Chants included: "From the river to the sea, Palestine will be free"; "From the sea to the river, Palestine will live forever"; "There is only one solution: Intifada revolution"; "Intifada, Intifada Long live the Intifada"; "Israel doesn't even have the right to exist"; and "2,4,6,8 We don't want a Jewish state." The disruptions were organized by a group called Students for Justice in Palestine. UC Davis police and other UC Davis administrators did nothing to stop them or enforce the anti-masking laws, despite requests from community members.
- g. On March 11, 2025, UC Davis Revolutionary Student Union and Students for Justice in Palestine chapter staged a "protest" event in the center of campus. In the presence of SJP members, followers, and faculty members, the keynote speaker openly advocated violence, specifically:

The sixth principle in which I've seen people waiver the most and get the most muddled is to support the right of resistance against Zionism

by any means necessary. This doesn't mean supporting resistance through art or literature or existence. This means supporting armed resistance first and foremost. Armed resistance is the foundation of the Palestinian movement towards liberation; it's something you need to fully support and you cannot say you are part of this movement at all if you don't. There is a narrative that we say Free Palestine but we don't agree with what resistance movements are doing. This is false. We need to back the resistance proudly (emphasis added).

- 22. Several individuals disturbed by these events, including UC Davis faculty, UC Davis alumni, and Davis community members—mostly but not entirely Jews—decided to pool their efforts to identify and expose what was happening at UC Davis.
- 23. Using the email aliases davisoctober7th@gmail.com and stopdavisantisemitism@gmail.com, petitioner Sixth Night Coalition submitted several records requests under the Public Records Act. Between June 2, 2024, and December 2, 2024, petitioner made 29 PRA submissions containing 70 specific records requests. All of these requests are itemized in the chart below.

UC Davis Failed to Produce Records Without Explanation

26. For 28 of these 70 specific requests, UC Davis ignored its own self-imposed due dates and produced no records, responsive or otherwise. The requests (described in the fifth column of the above chart at ¶23) are as follows: request numbers 5-18, 22-23, 25-26, 33, 38-40, 58, 62-65, and 68. They are highlighted in yellow on the above chart (¶23).

The Policies Identified By UC Davis Postdate Request/Need Earlier Versions

- 27. Seven of Petitioner's PRA requests sought university policies, rules, regulations, and/or guidelines on certain issues. These are request numbers 1-4, 31, and 69-70. They are highlighted in blue-grey on the chart (¶23 above).
- 28. UC Davis responded by sending current policies and/or links to various policies, but the university has recently revised several of its policies. With some exceptions, the links provided pull up current policies rather than the ones in effect at the time the requests were submitted. Additionally, some of the policies indicate that they were revised during the 2023-24 school year. Either way, our clients have not been furnished with the responsive policies applicable during all of the 2023-24 school year.

Some UC Davis Responses Pointed Petitioner to a Needle In Haystack

- 30. Regarding four of the 70 requests, UC Davis responded by citing to a general website. These are request numbers 19-21 and 24. They are highlighted in orange on the above chart (¶23).
- 31. Evidently, UC Davis believes it has fulfilled its duty by providing our clients with a haystack in which the requested information is hidden. California Government Code Section

² In the course of preparing this pleading, petitioner revised the information in the chart attached to petitioner's February 11 letter to respondent UC Davis. Petitioner clarified that one of the items listed under UCDPRA24577 in the February 11 chart was duplicative of UCDPRA24578, and could not confirm that UCDPRA24540 was sent. Therefore, petitioner has reduced the total number of individual items requested to 70. (The February 11 letter had identified 72 items.)

Davis has determined that there are no responsive records." Given the inadequacy of UC Davis' response to the TANA Request, Petitioner asked UC Davis to revise its response to this request as well.

- c. Request No. 29 (from UCDPRA24355): The PRA request sought all documents relating to the decision to delete or hide the content sought in the TANA Request from public view on or about June 25 or June 26, 2024. UC Davis responded: "Based on the finding for item 1, UC Davis has determined that there are no responsive records." Again, given the inadequacy of UC Davis' response to the TANA Request, Petitioner asked UC Davis to revise its response to this request too.
- d. Request No. 32 (from UCDPRA24365): The PRA request sought records of "any meeting or communication between Chancellor, Gary May, Ari Kelman, and/or Karl Englebach, and representatives of Davis Faculty for Israel, Aggies for Israel, Hillel, or other Jewish organizations, faculty, staff, or students."

UC Davis denied the request as too burdensome. Specifically, UC Davis stated:

We have reviewed your request and must respectfully deny it in its current form. Even "a clearly framed request" may be unduly burdensome if it "requires an agency to search an enormous volume of data for a 'needle in the haystack' or conversely, ...compels the production of a huge volume of material." California First Amendment Coalition v. Superior Ct. (1998) 67 Cal. App. 4th 159, 166. The request, as submitted, is not limited to specific communications or other types of documents. Nor is it limited to a timeframe or specific key words search. These parameters are necessary for us to be able to conduct a search pursuant to the California Public Records Act. Additionally, an overbroad collection, such as this, may comprise of records that may be exempt from disclosure for the following reasons:

- Records that protect individual privacy under the Federal Educational Rights and Privacy Act ("FERPA") (20 U.S.C. 1232g, student privacy), FERPA is a federal law that protects the privacy of records directly pertaining to students, and generally prohibits the disclosure of such records to the public without the consent of the affected student(s). (34 CFR 99.30 and 99.31).
- Personnel records. Gov. Code section § 7927.700 also allows for the non-disclosure of personnel records since disclosure would constitute an "unwarranted invasion of personal privacy."
- Records exempt pursuant to the attorney-client privilege and attorney work product doctrine [Government Code Section 7927.705].

Our office would like to assist you to make a focused request for identifiable records. If you feel you can focus this request to a reasonable number of specific records, please let me know and we

Petitioner's February 11, 2025, letter took UC Davis up on its suggestion and narrowed the scope of its PRA request. It limited the time period of the request to October 7, 2023-Present; and the parties to the request to those specifically identified above, i.e., any communications (including but not limited to emails, letters, and/or memoranda) between Chancellor Gary May, Ari Kelman, and/or Karl Englebach; with Davis Faculty for Israel, Aggies for Israel, and/or Hillel. To date, UC Davis has not responded as required by Cal. Gov't Code § 7922.535(a)-(b) by notifying Petitioner whether it has any responsive records; nor has it produced any responsive records to Petitioner.

e. Request No. 34 (from UCDPRA24365): The PRA request sought records related to the U.S. House investigation, specifically, records "referring or relating to UC Davis' or the University of California's assessment of each congressional inquiry of any American university leader by the House of Representatives Committee of Education and the Workforce since October 7, 2023." UC Davis responded by denying this as "not a records request" and as "unclear".

Contrary to UC Davis' purported response, this records request is clear; Petitioner seeks UC Davis' records referring or relating to the U.S. House of Representatives Committee on Education and the Workforce investigation(s) of antisemitism in higher education that began following Hamas' October 7, 2023 attack. That includes, but is not limited, to all emails, letters, and/or memoranda concerning same. Naturally, it includes any correspondence between UC Davis and the Congressional committee directly, and any communication with any members of the committee such as Congresswoman Virginia Foxx, but it is broader than that. For example, it covers internal memoranda discussing any committee requests.

- f. Request No. 37 (from UCDPRA24365): The PRA request sought: "All documents relating to audits or assessments evaluating how any of the above content 'promote[s] the role of art and culture as a viable community-building strategy' between UC Davis and the greater Woodland community.' [sic]" UC Davis responded: "Not a records request." Contrary to UC Davis' comments, this is a clear records request; Petitioner seeks any assessments and/or audits done of the anti-Zionist materials identified in item 27 above and how it promoted UC Davis' purpose in setting up/supporting TANA.
- g. Request Nos. 41-42 (from UCDPRA24369): These PRA requests sought all records describing the meaning of each the symbols displayed on the encampment signs or in graffiti left on the Quad. UC Davis responded that these were informational and not records requests. Contrary to UC Davis' response, these are records requests. Petitioner seeks UC Davis records discussing the meaning of symbols in encampment signs and/or graffiti. By way of example, this request would apply to any emails and/or memoranda by UC Davis staffers describing, asking about, or explaining Hamassupporters' use of an inverted red triangle to signify support for the Hamas terror organization.
- h. Request No. 43 (from UCDPRA24369): The PRA request sought all records identifying who or what "Al Qassam" is that was chanted by UAW on campus on or about June 11, 2024. UC Davis responded that these were informational and not records requests. Contrary to UC Davis' response, this is a records request. A simple search for any UC Davis records (including but

not limited to emails, letters, and/or memoranda referring to Al Qassam) should produce the responsive records; but UC Davis has not produced them to Petitioner.

Request No. 44 (from UCDPRA24369): The PRA request sought all records discussing whether UAW's protest on or about June 11, 2024 violated the University of California's restraining order against UAW. UC Davis responded: "Records do not exist, because there is no restraining order against the UAW at UC Davis."

UC Davis' response is disingenuous at best. There was a restraining order against UAW, signed June 7, 2024, in the case of Regents of the University of California v. UAW, Case No. 30-2024-01403666-CU-MC-CXC, Superior Court of California, County of Orange. To the best of Petitioner's knowledge, the order was effective throughout the University of California system; it was not limited to UCLA. Petitioner's request seeks UC Davis records discussing the relationship between the June 7 injunction and the June 11 protest.

Request No. 45 (from UCDPRA24369): The PRA request sought records referring/relating to George Habash, Leila Khaled. UC Davis responded:

> The University's ability to share personal information it maintains about individuals is governed by, among other laws, the California Information Practices Act ("IPA;" Calif. Civil Code § 1798 et seq.). In general, the IPA prohibits the University from disclosing "personal information" (broadly defined to include "any information that is maintained by an agency that identifies or describes an individual"), except in certain specified circumstances. The only IPA exception permits disclosure of such information if it is otherwise subject to disclosure under the California Public Records Act, which generally requires disclosure of public records. However, the PRA itself contains many exemptions to the general disclosure requirement, one of which is the privacy exemption § 7927.700 which provides that an agency is not required to disclose "Personnel, medical, or similar files, the disclosure of which would constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy." Therefore, under the PRA we would not conduct a search for the terms "George Habash" and/or "Leila Khaled."

UC Davis' response is nonsensical. Both Habash and Khaled are recognized terrorists, and Habash is dead.³ UC Davis' response appears designed to protect purported privacy records of recognized terrorists and/or a dead person. Contrary to the implication of UC Davis' response, Habash and Khaled are not minors, UC Davis students, or US citizens, nor did

letter (Exhibit "B")—petitioner's counsel received an email from Heather Urzua, Legal Operations Manager, UC Legal – UC Davis Office of the Campus Counsel (Exhibit "D"). The April 10 email "confirm[ed] receipt" of counsel's letter and asserted: "We will need an extended amount of time to thoroughly review your letter and spreadsheet and respond accordingly. We appreciate the narrowed information pertaining to some requests and will apply to those still open."

- 41. UC Davis' April 10 response failed to supply the missing records, failed to state clearly whether UC Davis had responsive records, and failed to state when those records would be provided. PRA law requires state agencies to provide the latter two within ten days after receiving an original PRA request. Cal. Gov't Code § 7922.535(a)-(b). In this case, months after petitioner originally submitted the PRA requests, UC Davis failed and refused to provide this basic information even after receiving a subsequent, follow-up inquiry.
- 42. UC Davis never responded further. As of July 10, 2025, three months after it sent the April 10 email, UC Davis had still failed to remedy the deficiencies identified in the February 11 letter.
- 43. That period is well beyond the length of time in which a public agency would be expected to respond to the requests submitted between June 2, 2024, and December 2, 2024.

COUNT I (Writ of Mandate For Violation of Public Records Act) Cal. Gov. Code §§ 7920.000 et seq.

- 44. Petitioner incorporates by reference the allegations set forth in the preceding paragraphs as though set forth at length herein.
- 45. As noted above, the PRA imposed a clear ministerial duty on Respondent Regents (acting directly or through its agents at UC Davis) to determine, within ten (10) days after receiving Petitioner's June 2, 2024-December 2, 2024, PRA requests, whether it was in possession of responsive, disclosable records. Once Regents determined that Petitioner's requests sought disclosable public records, the PRA also imposed a clear duty on it to specify in its notification the estimated date and time when the requested records would be made available. *See* Cal. Gov. Code § 7922.535(a).

- 46. As detailed above, Respondent Regents have failed to produce complete responses to Petitioner's PRA requests.
- 47. Regents have failed to perform their duties as required by the PRA, in violation of the California Constitution, Art. I, § 3, and the California Public Records Act, Cal. Gov. Code §§ 7920.000 *et seq*. Regents have thereby caused Petitioner to file suit to obtain the desired relief.
- 48. Petitioner has an immediate, vital, and beneficial interest in, and right to, Regents' performance of the aforementioned duties.
 - 49. Petitioner has no other plain, speedy, and adequate remedy at law.
- 50. There are no material issues of fact necessary to the resolution of this matter that are or can be disputed.
- 51. Section 10 of Article VI of the California Constitution provides that superior courts and their judges have original jurisdiction in proceedings for extraordinary relief in the nature of mandamus, certiorari, and prohibition. California Government Code section 7923.000 permits any person to institute proceedings for injunctive or declaratory relief or writ of mandate to enforce his or her right to inspect or to receive a copy of any public record under the PRA. Code of Civil Procedure section 1085 authorizes the Court to issue a writ of mandate to Regents to compel performance of the aforementioned mandatory duties under the PRA.

COUNT II (Declaratory Judgment and Injunctive Relief)

- 52. Petitioner incorporates by reference the allegations set forth in the preceding paragraphs as though set forth at length herein.
- 53. An actual controversy exists between Petitioner and Respondent Regents regarding Regents' mandatory duties under the Public Records Act.
- 54. Regents' failure to perform their clear duties under the Public Records Act. is a violation of both statutes.
- 55. Petitioner is being irreparably harmed by Regents' failure to perform their duties under the Public Records Act., and they will continue to be irreparably harmed unless Regents are compelled to comply with the law.

56. Petitioner has no plain, speedy, and adequate remedy at law.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Petitioner Sixth Night Coalition respectfully prays this Court:

- 1. For issuance of a writ of mandate ordering Regents of the University of California to provide all records responsive to Petitioner's PRA requests as set forth above;
- 2. Alternatively, if the Court does not order immediate production of the records requested, that it order Respondent to show cause why the records should not be released and prepare a log of withheld records, and thereafter issue a writ of mandate and injunction ordering the requested records to be disclosed;
- 3. For an Order of declarative and injunctive relief, including but not limited to, declaring that the withheld materials are public records as defined by Government Code section 7920.530, subdivision (a) in that they contain information relating to the conduct of the people's business, prepared, owned and retained by Respondent, and are subject to disclosure as writings of a public agency under Article 1, § 3(b) of the California Constitution; and declaring that Respondent violated the PRA by failing to promptly respond to Petitioner as they were required by law so to do, and also by failing to produce the requested responsive documents to Petitioner; and enjoining Regents to provide the requested records;
 - 4. For a finding that Petitioner is the prevailing party in this action;
- 5. For an award of attorney fees and costs to Petitioner pursuant to Government Code section 7923.115 or any other applicable law;
 - 6. For judgment accordingly; and

1	7. For such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.





Dear Sir or Madam:

This office represents the October 7 Coalition (email: <u>DavisOctober7th@gmail.com</u>) and Stop Davis Antisemitism (email: <u>stopdavisantisemitism@gmail.com</u>), which both submitted Public Records Act ("PRA") requests to the University of California Davis ("UC Davis"). Between June 2, 2024, and December 2, 2024, Stop Davis Antisemitism made 29 PRA submissions containing 72 specific records requests. All of these requests are itemized in the attached chart. Unfortunately, UC Davis has yet to produce a single record in response to several of our client's requests, and has been less than forthcoming in its productions for several others.

UCD Failed to Produce Records Without Explanation

For 29 of these 72 specific requests, UC Davis ignored its own self-imposed due dates and produced no records, responsive or otherwise. The requests (described in the fifth column of the attached chart) are as follows: request numbers 5-18, 22-23, 25-26, 33, 38-40, 58, 63-66, and 68-69. They are highlighted in **yellow** on the attached spreadsheet.

Policies Identified Postdate Request/Need Earlier Versions

Seven of our clients' PRA requests sought university policies, rules, regulations, and/or guidelines on certain issues. These are request numbers 1-4, 31, and 71-72. They are highlighted in **blue-grey** on the attached spreadsheet.

UC Davis responded by sending current policies and/or links to various policies, but the university has recently revised several of its policies. With some exceptions, the links provided pull up current policies rather than the ones in effect at the time the requests were submitted.

¹ The exceptions are UC Davis Policy on Student Conduct and Discipline, effective September 1, 2020; Policy 270-70 regarding Major Events Sponsored by RSOs and Other Non-University Organizations, effective July 18, 2023; Policy 310-27 regarding Temporary Postings, effective July 3, 2024, and prior policies dating back to December 17, 2014; and Policy 400-01 regarding Freedom of Expression, effective January 4, 2024, rev. February 27, 2024.

Additionally, some of the policies indicate that they were revised during the 2023-24 school year. Either way, our clients have not been furnished with the responsive policies applicable during all of the 2023-24 school year.

We request you provide copies of all missing responsive policies denoted in the following chart:

Needle In Haystack

Regarding four of the 72 requests, UCD responded by citing to a general website. These are request numbers 19-21 and 24. They are highlighted in **orange** on the attached spreadsheet.

Evidently, UCD believes it has fulfilled its duty by providing our clients with a haystack in which the requested information is hidden. California Government Code Section 7922.545 actually states that the agency may satisfy its obligation by "directing a member of the public to the *location on the internet website where the public record is posted*" (*emphasis added*). Kindly provide a link to the webpage containing the requested information, or provide actual records that contain the requested information; and not a haystack in which the information is hidden.

Closed Without Production

UCD closed 21 of the 72 requests without producing any records. They are request numbers 27-29, 32, 34-37, 41-52, and 61. (The requests are numbered cumulatively; there is no individual PRA request with 61 subparts.) They are highlighted in **light green** on the attached spreadsheet.

We believe several of these refusals to produce records were legally insupportable. Below we have provided descriptions of the requests and explained our questions about UCD's closure of the requests:

27 (UCDPRA24355)

<u>PRA request</u>: Copies of all Instagram, blogs, and other social media content, teeshirts and other paraphernalia (hereinafter "content"), by or on behalf of Tana Gallery, and/or the Department of Chicana/Chicano Studies, relating to antisemitism, Jews, Palestine, Hamas, PFLP,

PULP, Hesbollah [a/k/a Hezbollah], SJP, the UC Davis Encampment, or "anticolonialism", from August 31, 2023 to the present.

<u>UCD response</u>: "Pursuant to the California Public Records Act, UC Davis has conducted a reasonable search and determined that there are no responsive records."²

<u>Comment</u>: TANA's website does in fact contain responsive material. Attached please find a sample of same. We request UCD revise its response to avoid the need for unnecessary litigation/incursion of attorney fees owing to our clients.

28 (UCDPRA24355)

PRA request: All metadata related to the creation, generation, and/or posting of such content, including but not limited to the date and time of creation, generation, and posting, IP addresses of the hardware used, associated user IDs, whether such hardware is property of the University of California or the State of California, to which University officials, such hardware is assigned, but name, classification, department, etc.

<u>UCD response</u>: "Based on the finding for item 1, UC Davis has determined that there are no responsive records."

<u>Comment</u>: Based on our comment to item 27 above, we request UCD review and revise its response to avoid the need for unnecessary litigation/incursion of attorney fees owing to our clients.

29 (UCDPRA24355)

<u>PRA request</u>: All documents relating to the decision to delete or hide such content from public view on or about June 25 or June 26, 2024.

<u>UCD response</u>: "Based on the finding for item 1, UC Davis has determined that there are no responsive records."

<u>Comment</u>: Based on our comment to item 27 above, we request UCD review its records and produce all records relating to any decision to delete or hide the social media content described in item 27.

32 (UCDPRA24365)

<u>PRA request</u> sought records of "any meeting or communication between Chancellor, Gary May, Ari Kelman, and/or Karl Englebach, and representatives of Davis Faculty for Israel, Aggies for Israel, Hillel, or other Jewish organizations, faculty, staff, or students."

<u>UCD denied the request</u> as too burdensome. Specifically:

We have reviewed your request and must respectfully deny it in its current form. Even "a clearly framed request" may be unduly burdensome if it "requires an agency to search an enormous volume of data for a 'needle in the haystack' or conversely, ... compels the production of a huge volume of material." *California First Amendment Coalition v. Superior Ct.* (1998) 67 Cal. App. 4th 159, 166. The request, as submitted, is not limited to specific communications or other types of documents. Nor is it limited to a timeframe or specific key words search. These parameters are necessary for us to be able to conduct a search pursuant to the California Public Records Act. Additionally, an overbroad collection, such as this, may comprise of records that may be exempt from disclosure for the following reasons:

- Records that protect individual privacy under the Federal Educational Rights and Privacy Act ("FERPA") (20 U.S.C. 1232g, student privacy), FERPA is a federal law that protects the privacy of records directly pertaining to students, and generally prohibits the disclosure of such records to the public without the consent of the affected student(s). (34 CFR 99.30 and 99.31).
- Personnel records. Gov. Code section § 7927.700 also allows for the non-disclosure of personnel records since disclosure would constitute an "unwarranted invasion of personal privacy."
- Records exempt pursuant to the attorney-client privilege and attorney work product doctrine [Government Code Section 7927.705].

Our office would like to assist you to make a focused request for identifiable records. If you feel you can focus this request to a reasonable number of specific records, please let me know and we will continue to work with you to provide the documents you seek.

<u>Comment</u>: Thank you for offering to assist our clients in making a more focused request. The time period of the request is limited to October 7, 2023-Present. The parties to the request are limited to those specifically identified above, i.e., any communications (including but not limited to emails, letters, and/or memoranda) between Chancellor Gary May, Ari Kelman, and/or Karl Englebach; with Davis Faculty for Israel, Aggies for Israel, and/or Hillel.

34 (UCDPRA 24365)

<u>PRA request</u> sought records related to the U.S. House investigation, specifically, records "referring or relating to UC Davis's or the University of California's assessment of each congressional inquiry of any American university leader by the House of Representatives Committee of Education and the Workforce since October 7, 2023." <u>UCD responded</u> by denying this as "not a records request" and as "unclear".

Comment: Contrary to UCD's comments, this is a clear records request. Our clients want UCD's records referring or relating to the U.S. House of Representatives Committee on Education and the Workforce investigation(s) of antisemitism in higher education that began following Hamas' October 7, 2023 attack. That includes, but is not limited, to all emails, letters, and/or memoranda concerning same. Naturally, it includes any correspondence between UCD and the Congressional committee directly, and any communication with any members of the committee such as Congresswoman Virginia Foxx, but it is broader than that. For example, it covers internal memoranda discussing any committee requests.

35 (UCDPRA 24365)

<u>PRA request</u> sought current employment status of Eddie Lampkin. <u>UCD response</u>: "No employee was found matching the name 'Eddie Lampkin'." <u>Comment</u>: **THIS REQUEST IS WITHDRAWN**.

36 (UCDPRA 24365)

PRA request: "All communications relating or referring to any of the above." <u>UCD</u> responded by denying request as unduly burdensome. <u>Comment</u>: **THIS REQUEST IS WITHDRAWN**.

37 (UCDPRA 24365)

PRA request: "All documents relating to audits or assessments evaluating how any of the above content 'promote[s] the role of art and culture as a viable community-building strategy' between UC Davis and the greater Woodland community.' [sic]" UCD responded: "Not a records request."

<u>Comment</u>: Contrary to UCD's comments, this is a clear records request. Our clients seek any assessments and/or audits done of the anti-Zionist materials identified in item 27 above and how it promoted UCD's purpose in setting up/supporting TANA.

41-42 (UCDPRA 24369)

<u>PRA request</u> sought all records describing the meaning of each the symbols displayed on the encampment signs or in graffiti left on the Quad. <u>UCD responded</u> that these were informational and not records requests.

Comment: Contrary to UCD's response, these are records requests. Our clients seek UCD records discussing the meaning of symbols in encampment signs and/or graffiti. By way of example, this request would apply to any emails and/or memoranda by UCD staffers describing, asking about, or explaining Hamas-supporters' use of an inverted red triangle to signify support for the Hamas terror organization.³

43 (UCDPRA 24369)

PRA request sought all records identifying who or what "Al Qassam" is that was chanted by UAW on campus on or about June 11, 2024. <u>UCD responded</u> that these were informational and not records requests.

<u>Comment</u>: Contrary to UCD's response, this is a records request. A simple search for any UCD records (including but not limited to emails, letters, and/or memoranda referring to Al Qassam should produce the responsive records.

44 (UCDPRA 24369)

<u>PRA request</u> sought all records discussing whether UAW's protest on or about June 11, 2024 violated UC's restraining order against UAW. <u>UCD responded</u>: "Records do not exist, because there is no restraining order against the UAW at UC Davis."

Comment: This response appears to be disingenuous. There certainly was a restraining order against UAW, signed June 7, 2024, in the case of *Regents of the University of California v. UAW*, Case No. 30-2024-01403666-CU-MC-CXC, Superior Court of California, County of Orange. The order appears to have been effective throughout the University of California system, not limited to UC Davis. Our clients' request seeks UCD records discussing the relationship between the June 7 injunction and the June 11 protest. Again, we are particularly seeking emails, letters, and/or memoranda.

45 (UCDPRA 24369)

PRA request sought records referring/relating to George Habash, Leila Khaled. UCD response: "The University's ability to share personal information it maintains about individuals is governed by, among other laws, the California Information Practices Act ("IPA;" Calif. Civil Code § 1798 et seq.). In general, the IPA prohibits the University from disclosing

"personal information" (broadly defined to include "any information that is maintained by an agency that identifies or describes an individual"), except in certain specified circumstances. The only IPA exception permits disclosure of such information if it is otherwise subject to disclosure under the California Public Records Act, which generally requires disclosure of public records. However, the PRA itself contains many exemptions to the general disclosure requirement, one of which is the privacy exemption § 7927.700 which provides that an agency is not required to disclose "Personnel, medical, or similar files, the disclosure of which would constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy." Therefore, under the PRA we would not conduct a search for the terms "George Habash" and/or "Leila Khaled"."

Comment: Habash and Khaled are not minors, UCD students, or US citizens, nor have our clients asked for medical information or other information that could be considered confidential; and Habash is no longer alive. Both Habash and Khaled are recognized terrorists.⁴ Perhaps we misread UCD's response, but it appears that UCD denied our clients' request for records about terrorists George Habash and Leila Khaled on the grounds that the request violated the terrorists' privacy rights. Please clarify whether that was your intention. If so, please identify on what applicable basis you are refusing to produce information about Habash and Khaled.

46 (UCDPRA 24369)

<u>PRA request</u> sought records re Party for Socialism and Liberation and/or Cops Off Campus. UCD responded, not a records request/request unclear.

<u>Comment</u>: Contrary to UCD's comments, we believe that this is a clear records request. Nevertheless, for now, we are willing to revise the request to all records referring to Party for Socialism and Liberation and/or Cops Off Campus, including but not limited to emails, letters, and/or memoranda, for the time period October 7, 2023-present.

47 (UCDPRA 24369)

PRA request sought records re conferral of 2024 University Medal on Brooke Morey. UCD responded with a link to a UC Davis public relations feature story,⁵ and denied the

request otherwise, claiming that "student records" are private education records under FERPA (20 USC § 1232g) and exempt under PRA (Gov't Code § 7927.700).

<u>Comment</u>: This response is, again, disingenuous. Our clients did not seek personal records of Brooke Morey, but rather records about UCD's conferral of an award upon her. Where are the university's records of its decision to award the medal to Morey? What was the basis for the university's decision? Our clients are entitled to have these records produced.

48 (UCDPRA 24369)

<u>PRA request</u> sought records relating/referring to Hannah Zeltzer, Stanford McConnehey, Batool Alawadi, and/or Yara Kaadan. <u>UCD responded</u> that any response would violate the California Information Practices Act (CA Civil Code § 1798 *et seq.*) and be exempt under PRA § 7927.700.

Comment: Our clients do not seek any information protected from disclosure by the California Information Practices Act or exempt under the PRA. Nevertheless, it is difficult for us to credit that *every* UCD record referring or relating to these students is protected from disclosure, given that all four are anti-Zionist activists who have been in the news in relation to the campus disruptions since October 7, 2023. For example, McConnehey is or was the spokesman for the Popular University for the Liberation of Palestine (PULP) when it set up the encampment at UCD last spring.⁶ Kaadan, Alawadi, and Zeltzer are all activists with Students for Justice in Palestine,⁷ an organization which has disrupted⁸ several campi to such an extent that they saw fit to suspend or terminate the organization.⁹ Surely, their names came up in disclosable records, such

49 (UCDPRA 24369)

PRA request sought records relating/referring to Lysandra Dasilva, Nathan Orr, and/or Cheyenne Xiong. UCD responded that any response would violate the California Information Practices Act (CA Civil Code § 1798 et seq.) and be exempt under PRA § 7927.700.

<u>Comment</u>: Our clients do not seek any information protected from disclosure by the California Information Practices Act or exempt under the PRA. Nor has UCD alleged any facts that would support its supposed exemption claims. Our clients simply seek university records about three individuals **arrested for vandalizing the UCD campus**. We await responsive records.

50 (UCDPRA 24369)

PRA request sought records relating or referring to "National SJP 2024 Summer School." <u>UCD responded</u> that this was not a records request/request unclear.

<u>Comment</u>: Contrary to UCD's comments, we believe that this is a clear records request. Nevertheless, for now, we are willing to revise the request to all records referring to National SJP 2024 Summer School (or some permutation thereof, such as National Students for Justice in Palestine 2024 Summer School), including but not limited to emails, letters, and/or memoranda.

51 (UCDPRA 24369)

<u>PRA request</u>: "All records of communications, relating to any of the above items, directed to, by, or copying any of the following: Chancellor Gary May, Mike Sweeny, Ari Kelman, Joe Farrow, any other representative of the Chancellor's Office, UCOP, the Office of Student Affairs, HDAAP, or UC Davis PD." <u>UCD response</u> denied as unduly burdensome. <u>Comment</u>: **THIS REQUEST IS WITHDRAWN**.

Kindly respond to this letter and produce all responsive records by ____, 2025. Please note that if we do not receive a response and all requested records by that date, our clients are prepared to file suit. In that case, our clients shall certainly request that UC Davis pay their attorney fees and costs, as provided for in the PRA statute. Pursuant to Government Code § 7923.115(a), "If the requester prevails in litigation filed pursuant to this chapter, the court shall award court costs and reasonable attorney's fees to the requester."
