

**Yarnell Regional Community Center  
2025 Annual Meeting  
February 11, 2025, at 4:30 pm at the YRCC**

The 2025 Annual Meeting opened with a YRCC Board and Staff provided potluck at 4:30pm. Vice President Maureen Schufft opened the meeting at 4:40 pm and welcomed all in attendance and introduced the current Board Members – Maureen Schufft, Leah Tidey, Frances Lechner, Mike Brown, Denise Manone, Paul Jones, and Roxie Barringer.

Minutes from the 2024 Annual Meeting were reviewed by a Minutes Committee appointed by the Board of Directors. The Committee consisted of Larry Oldman, Trish Edwards and Peggy Looper. Vice President Maureen Schufft asked the five nominees for Board positions to introduce and speak a little about themselves. Member voting took place with paper ballots for the four open positions and five nominees – Roxie Barringer, Stella Lee, Liz Manning, Mark Peck and Roy Rose.

Frances Lechner acknowledged the leaving Board members – Paul Jones, Denise Manone, and Maureen Schufft. Each was given a Certificate of Appreciation.

## **REPORTS**

**Treasurer's Report** – Frances Lechner reviewed growth in Income Chart from 2018 to 2024 noting that 2024 actual income was 39% NACOG and 61% from the Thrift Store, Grants, Club Yarnell, and Community Donations. Thank you! The 2025 Budget was presented.

**Executive Director's Report** – Jimmy Miller reviewed 2024 accomplishments; the Meals on Wheels Impact covers 400sq miles from Skull Valley to Congress; over 15k meals delivered (MOW and the YRCC family, client experiences and what driver's do for clients). Club Yarnell events and collaboration with other entities such as the library, churches, school, Community Garden and community working together. Improvements at the YRCC include new dining room cabinets, new dining room floor and lighting, Thrift Store ceiling, generator, and beautification of the Wheelhouse. Thank you to all who donated time and resources. The YRCC has a good team in place with staff, volunteers and the Board of Directors. The Year in Review – introducing a new Club Yarnell logo and all the successful 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary events.

**People For People** – Presented by Sand Jones McClintock. P4P is a pilot volunteer program created and supported by YRCC to enhance health and wellbeing among vulnerable community members.

**Lifetime Achievement Award** – The new "Buck Stops Here" board has been installed in the dining room. A plaque with 2024 honorees has been applied. 2025 honorees are Paul Jones and Rebecca Wilks.

**Election Results** – 35 votes cast. Counting of ballots was done by Jane and Dick Meyers. The new Board members are Liz Manning, Mark Peck and Roy Rose. The continuing Board member is Roxie Barringer.

**Closing Announcements** – Frances Lechner thanked all for coming to the 2025 Annual Meeting and announced that Jimmy Miller, current Executive Director would be retiring effective July 1, 2025.
