



AKOYA CHANDELIER

The Pearl Chandelier is clearly inspired by organic forms, lily pads, oyster shells, plant tendrils, but at the same time is a rationally conceived, architectural form that is driven by the material of its construction: wood. Like the triangulated trusses of a timber frame barn, the carved arms and supports are shaped to carry their weight, and function as members of a well-balanced wooden structure. Carving of this quality declined with the passing of the great masters of Art Nouveau, Gaudi, etc. The Pearl is a modern reinvention of this tradition one hundred years later.

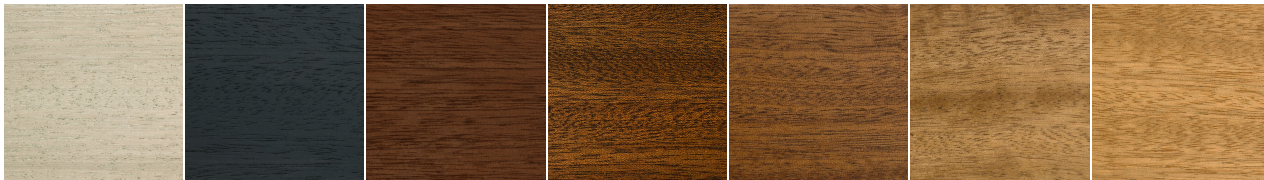
