1 Scope and Purpose

1. These Terms and Conditions (hereinafter referred to as the "T&Cs") govern all services and activities offered on the German Finance Dinner website (hereinafter referred to as the "Event Website"). The event is organised by Finance Network e.V. (Mombacher Straße 68, 55122 Mainz, Germany) (hereinafter referred to as the "Organiser").
2. Any terms and conditions submitted by a user that differ from, conflict with, or supplement these T&Cs shall not become part of the contract unless explicitly agreed to in writing.
3. The Organiser reserves the right to amend or update these T&Cs at any time. The most recent version will be published on the Event Website.

3 Description of the Event

1. The German Finance Dinner is an exclusive annual gathering designed to bring together exceptionally talented students in finance and top executives from leading global financial institutions.
2. The date, location, and schedule of the next event will be published on the Event Website at germanfinancedinner.com. The evening typically includes:
 - Networking sessions between students and executives
 - Speeches and keynote addresses

- Themed dinner discussions
- A concluding get-together

3. Details regarding the programme, schedule, and participating executives will be published on the Event Website and updated regularly. However, the Organiser reserves the right to make changes.

4 Application and Attendance

1. Application:

- Prospective participants may apply online through the dedicated application form on the Event Website.
- The application process requires truthful and complete information. Applicants must promptly update any changes to their details.
- Submitting an application does not guarantee a place at the event.

2. Confirmation of Participation:

- An applicant is only entitled to attend the event once the Organiser provides a formal confirmation (e.g., an official acceptance message or ticket).
- The Organiser reserves the right to refuse or revoke an application at its sole discretion without stating any reason.

5 Cancellation and Event Changes

1. Cancellation by Participants:

- Should a participant need to cancel, the cancellation must be made in writing (e.g., via email) to the Organiser.
- Specific deadlines and any relevant cancellation instructions will be communicated separately, if applicable.

2. Changes or Cancellation by the Organiser:

- The Organiser reserves the right to cancel or reschedule the event for important reasons (e.g., force majeure, venue unavailability, unforeseen circumstances).
- If the event is cancelled, the Organiser will inform applicants and participants as soon as possible. Unless otherwise indicated by mandatory law, no liability for damages shall be assumed, except where caused by the Organiser's gross negligence or wilful misconduct.

6 Liability

1. Organiser's Liability:

- The Organiser shall only be liable for damages caused by its own gross negligence or wilful misconduct, or that of its legal representatives or vicarious agents.
- In cases of slight negligence involving essential contractual obligations, liability is limited to the typical foreseeable damages.

- Any further liability for slight negligence is excluded, unless mandatory statutory provisions require otherwise.

2. External Links:

- The Event Website may contain links to external third-party websites. The Organiser has no influence on the content of these websites and assumes no liability for their content.
- The respective provider or website owner is always responsible for the content of linked pages.

3. Accuracy of Information:

- While the Organiser endeavours to keep the information on the Event Website updated and accurate, it cannot be held responsible for any errors, omissions, or outdated content.
- The Organiser reserves the right to modify, add, or remove content at its sole discretion.

7 Intellectual Property and Unauthorised Use

1. Copyright and Intellectual Property:

- The content on the Event Website (including, but not limited to, text, images, graphics, logos, and other media) is the intellectual property of the Organiser or is used under licence. It is protected by applicable copyright and other intellectual property laws.
- Any duplication, distribution, modification, or reproduction of these materials beyond what is legally permitted requires the prior written consent of the Organiser.

2. Legal Enforcement of Unauthorised Use:

- Any unauthorised copying, sharing, or otherwise illicit use of the Event Website's content or parts thereof will be subject to legal action.
- This includes, but is not limited to, textual descriptions, unique programme elements, and other distinctive features of the German Finance Dinner event.

8 Data Protection, Commercial Use and Transfer

1. The Organiser adheres to applicable data protection regulations. However, explicitly broad rights regarding data usage are agreed upon as a condition of application.

2. Unrestricted Transfer and Commercial Use:

- By submitting the application form, the applicant explicitly grants the Organiser the worldwide, irrevocable, and unrestricted right to share, transfer, and distribute their application data (including, but not limited to, CVs, academic records, and contact details) to third parties.
- **Commercial Monetisation:** The applicant expressly consents that the Organiser may use the provided data for commercial purposes, including the sale, licensing, or monetisation of the data to third parties (e.g., via paid access to CV books or talent databases).
- **Recipients:** Data may be transferred to any partner of the Organiser. This includes commercial partners (sponsors paying for access), non-commercial partners, affiliated networks, and other third parties, regardless of whether a direct contractual or financial relationship exists between the

Organiser and the third party.

- **Purpose of Use:** The data may be used by the Organiser and third-party recipients for any purpose, including but not limited to recruitment, marketing, general business operations, and analytics.

9 Governing Law and Jurisdiction

1. These T&Cs and any resulting disputes shall be governed by the substantive laws of the Federal Republic of Germany, excluding the UN Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods (CISG).

2. If the participant is a business entity or has no general jurisdiction within Germany, any disputes arising from or in connection with these T&Cs shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent court at the Organiser's registered office, unless otherwise specified by mandatory statutory provisions.

10 Final Provisions

1. Severability Clause:

- Should any provision of these T&Cs be invalid or unenforceable, the validity of the remaining provisions shall not be affected.
- In place of the invalid provision, a valid provision that closely reflects the intended commercial purpose shall be substituted.

2. No Oral Agreements:

- There are no oral side agreements. Any changes or additions to these T&Cs must be in writing. This also applies to any waiver of the written form requirement itself.

3. By using the Event Website and submitting an application, applicants acknowledge and accept these T&Cs as legally binding.
