Sign Care

How to Care for a Vehicle Wrap

- Treat your vehicle wrap as a custom paint job and try your best to avoid scratches and peeling.
- **HAND WASH ONLY**
- No pressure washing
- Keep the vehicle out of the sun when possible.
- For especially difficult insects or stains, try soaking for several minutes with warm, soapy water to avoid scrubbing that will damage the film.
- Non-abrasive automotive specific detergents only.
- Rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- Always use a clean microfiber cloth to wash and dry.
- **DO NOT** use ammonia based solvents, like Windex.
- **DO NOT** use polishing compounds with abrasives.

How to Care for Perforated Window Film

- Wash with mild soap and water.
- Use a soft cloth/sponge to wash and dry.
- Soak bugs and dirt with warm water to avoid scrubbing.
- **DO NOT** turn on heating or defrosting elements.
- **DO NOT** use rear windshield wipers
- **DO NOT** open or roll down the windows

Magnetic Sign Care

Your magnetic sign is built to last, with a strong holding power of 85 pounds per square foot and a flexible magnetic material that performs reliably in temperatures ranging from -10°F to 160°F. For best results, make sure both the vehicle surface and the brown magnetic side of the sign are clean, dry, and waxed before applying.

To install, start by placing one edge of the sign against the vehicle and let the magnet do the rest—if it's not positioned exactly how you want, simply peel it off and try again. During winter, ensure the sign itself is at least 50°F for proper adhesion.

To maintain your vehicle's finish, it's important to remove the sign weekly and wipe down both surfaces to prevent moisture buildup. Cleaning is easy—just use warm water and mild detergent on the display side. When not in use, store the sign flat or roll it (printed side out) around a 3-inch diameter tube, and avoid placing heavy items on top to prevent damage.
