The Organ was built for the Church of Saint Mark, Battersea Rise in 1874 by T C Lewis. It was rebuilt and enlarged in 1912 by Lewis & Co. and removed and placed in storage in 2012. The installation at Most Precious Blood was undertaken by Gary Owens Organ Builders and Renatus Ltd in 2022. It has 3 manuals, 46 speaking stops and 2,122 pipes.
