October: October is the month of the Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary - the Rosary will therefore be said before each of our weekend Masses throughout the month, at 5.30pm on Saturday, and 10.30am on a Sunday. Book of Remembrance: We have bought a new 'Book of Remembrance' for use in November. This book will replace the two loose-leaf folders we have been using up to now, combining names from both the Saturday and Sunday Mass communities as a sign of our unity. The new book is organised by date for each month, so that the departed will be remembered on the date of their anniversary. Since we have not got those dates at present, we will need to 'start again' with our lists: if you would like any names to be added to the new book, please let us have the name and date of death on one of the sheets available at the back of church. We would also like the book to be a beautiful memorial to our departed loved ones - hence if you have got good handwriting (or know someone who has), please let Fr Bernard know if you could help with this.
