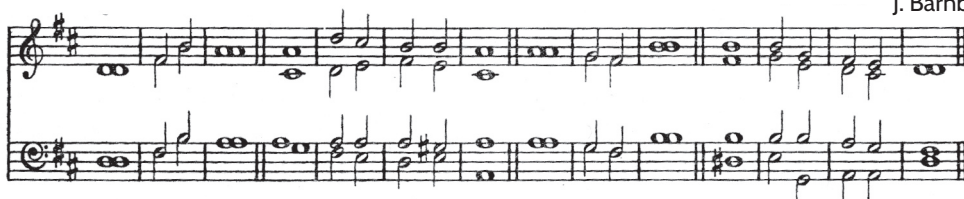

Parish Life

All Souls: please note that, as is our custom, there is an extra Mass for All Souls on Monday, at 6pm. Also, a Requiem Mass for the Dead of War will be celebrated next Sunday (9th November) for Remembrance Day.

November: November is the month of the Holy Souls, and unless otherwise requested, all Mass will be offered for the Holy Souls. In addition, each week we will celebrate one weekday Requiem Mass, during which the names of those we remember in our new 'Book of Remembrance' will be read out (after the Gospel). Please remember to let us have these names, with the date of their death (or as close as possible - see separate notice). Each week will cover 3 month of the year (week 1 January to March, week 2 April to June, etc.). Also, in line with our obligations to the Guild of Our Lady of Ransom (who kindly gave us a grant towards Evangelisation efforts and the repair of the church bell), we will celebrate at least five Masses 'for the forgotten dead' in November.

Book of Remembrance: We have bought a new 'Book of Remembrance' for use in November. This book will replace the two loose-leaf folders we have been using up to now, combining names from Saturday and Sunday Mass communities as a sign of unity. This book is organised monthly by date, so the departed will be remembered on their anniversary. As we don't yet have those dates, we need to 'start again' with our lists. Please let us have the name and date of death of anyone you want added on one of the sheets available at the back of church. We would also like the book to be a beautiful memorial to our departed loved ones - hence if you have got good handwriting (or know someone who has), please let Fr Bernard know if you could help with this.

****When adding names to the list, please remember to add the date of death for each entry. Many thanks for your cooperation.**

Stop assisted suicide - further action needed! Sending a physical letter carries particular weight with Members of the House of Lords. Right To Life UK has created a simple tool that generates personalised letters to Peers, each focused on a specific area of concern. You can then print them, or copy them out by hand, sign, and post them. Please take action now and visit www.righttolife.org.uk/aspeersletter to send a letter to Peers asking them to oppose assisted suicide. 2nd November (All Saints) - *"As we commemorate the solemnity of All Saints today and All Souls tomorrow, we ask Almighty God to especially care for all those approaching the end of their lives. May they be granted a peaceful, natural death with dignity and the appropriate palliative care. Lord hear us".*

Hymns: For both Saturday and Sunday Masses, we would like to make sure that hymns are as well-known as possible to the congregation. To help with this, please let us know about your favourite hymns by entering them into our white 'Suggestions Book', which is kept on the table by the door at the back of church. We will then review entries and use them to inform hymn choices. Many thanks!

Children's Liturgy: We are considering offering a children's liturgy at the Sunday 11am Mass in future, which some families have expressed an interest in. This would allow younger children to receive some teaching geared especially to their age during the Liturgy of the Word (i.e. after the Collect Prayer and returning to Mass for the Prayers/Offertory). If you would consider helping with this, please speak to Fr Bernard - materials and training will be provided.
