March for Life: On 29th April, the Crime and Policing Bill – containing the clause decriminalising abortion – received Royal Assent and passed into law. The provisions of the decriminalisation clause came into effect immediately. This is a devastating outcome. Unborn babies have been stripped of nearly all legal protection. Self-induced abortion is now legal up to birth. It is more important than ever that Catholics stand up for those without a voice. Adoration: many thanks to all those who made suggestions regarding additional times for regular Eucharistic Adoration in the parish.
