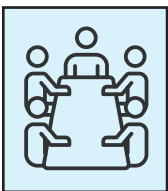
# Annual Spring Update



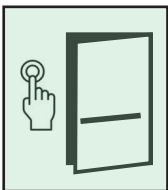
Highlights from Lake Sunapee Region VNA & Hospice to keep our community updated
